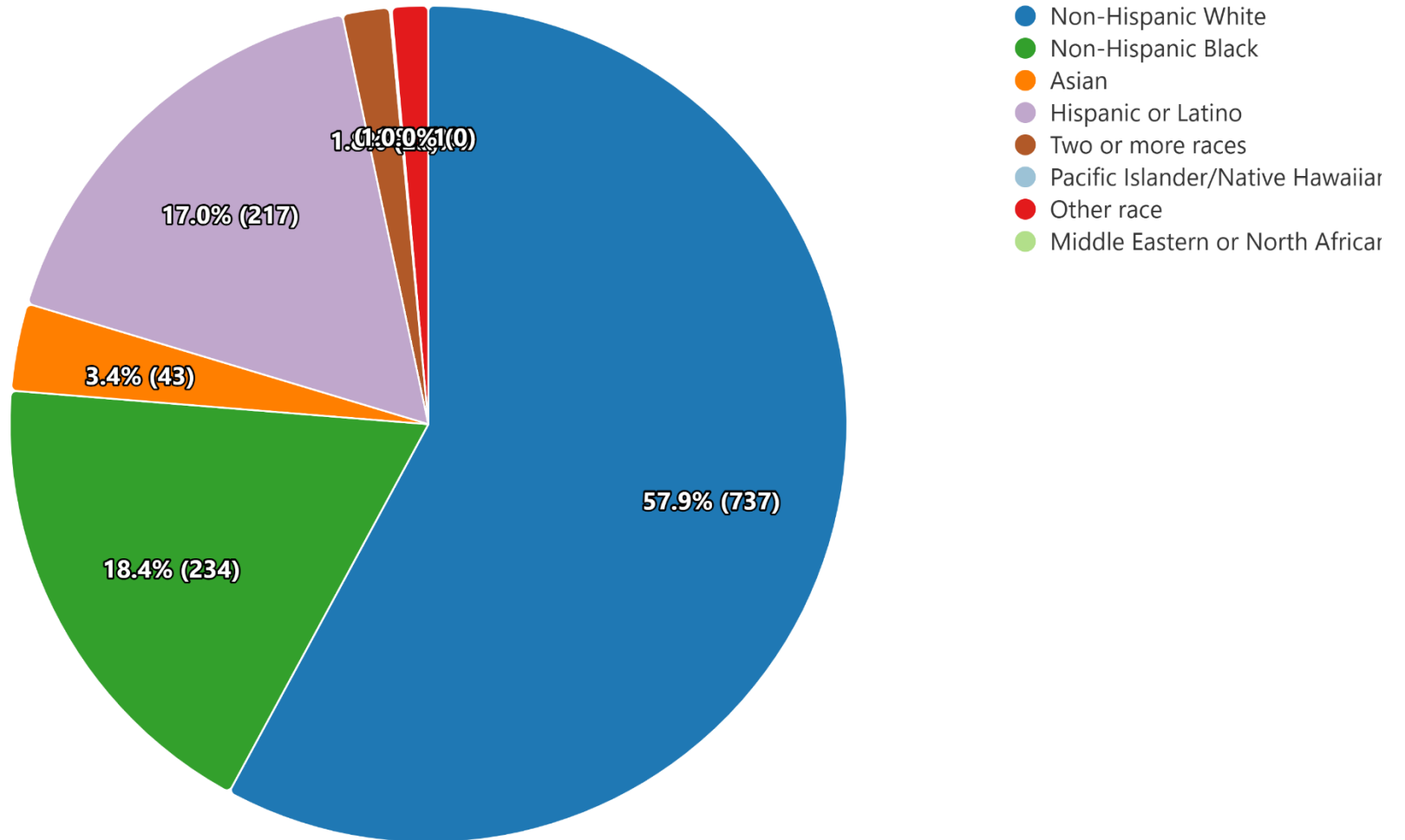

Cabarrus County, NC, 2025

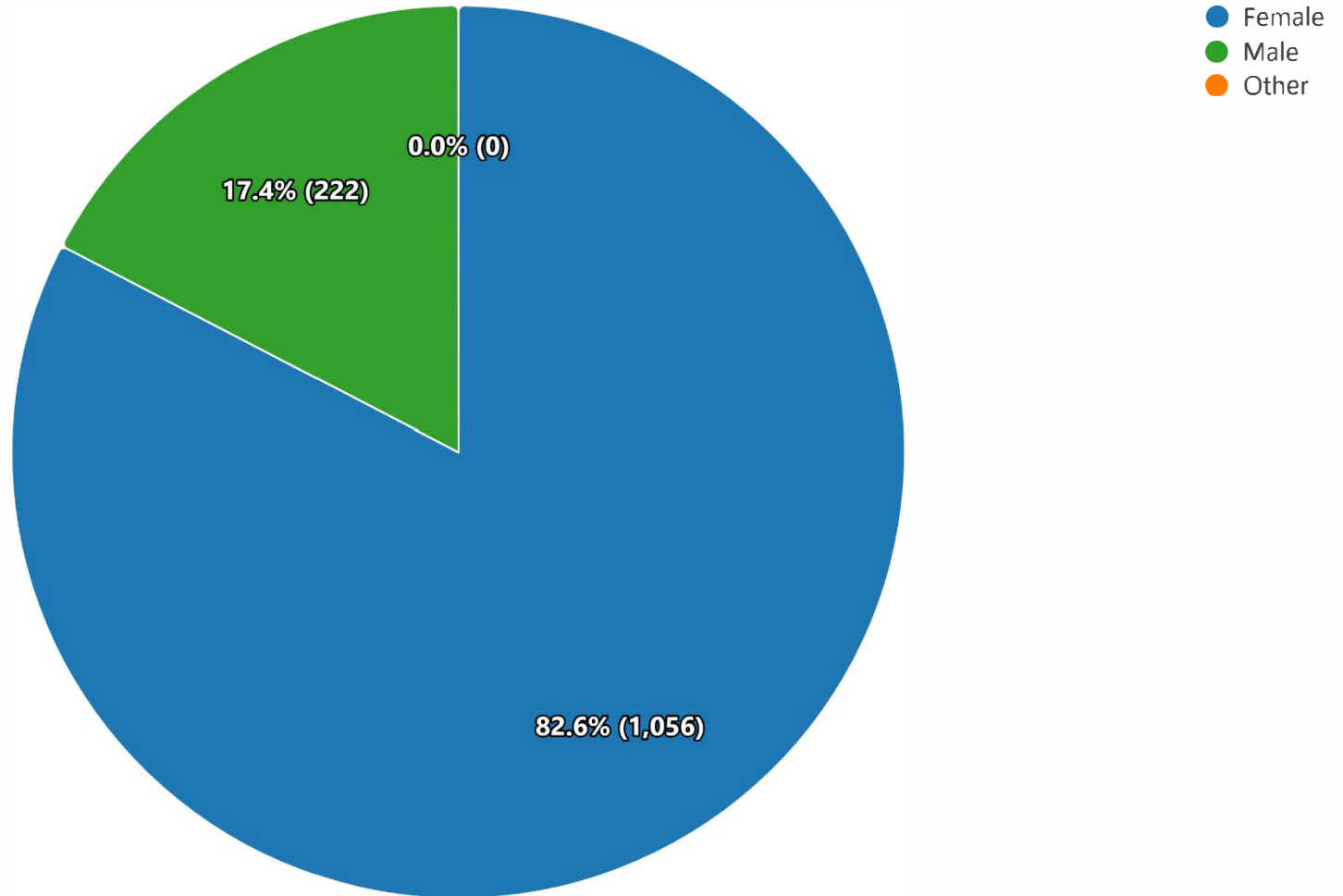

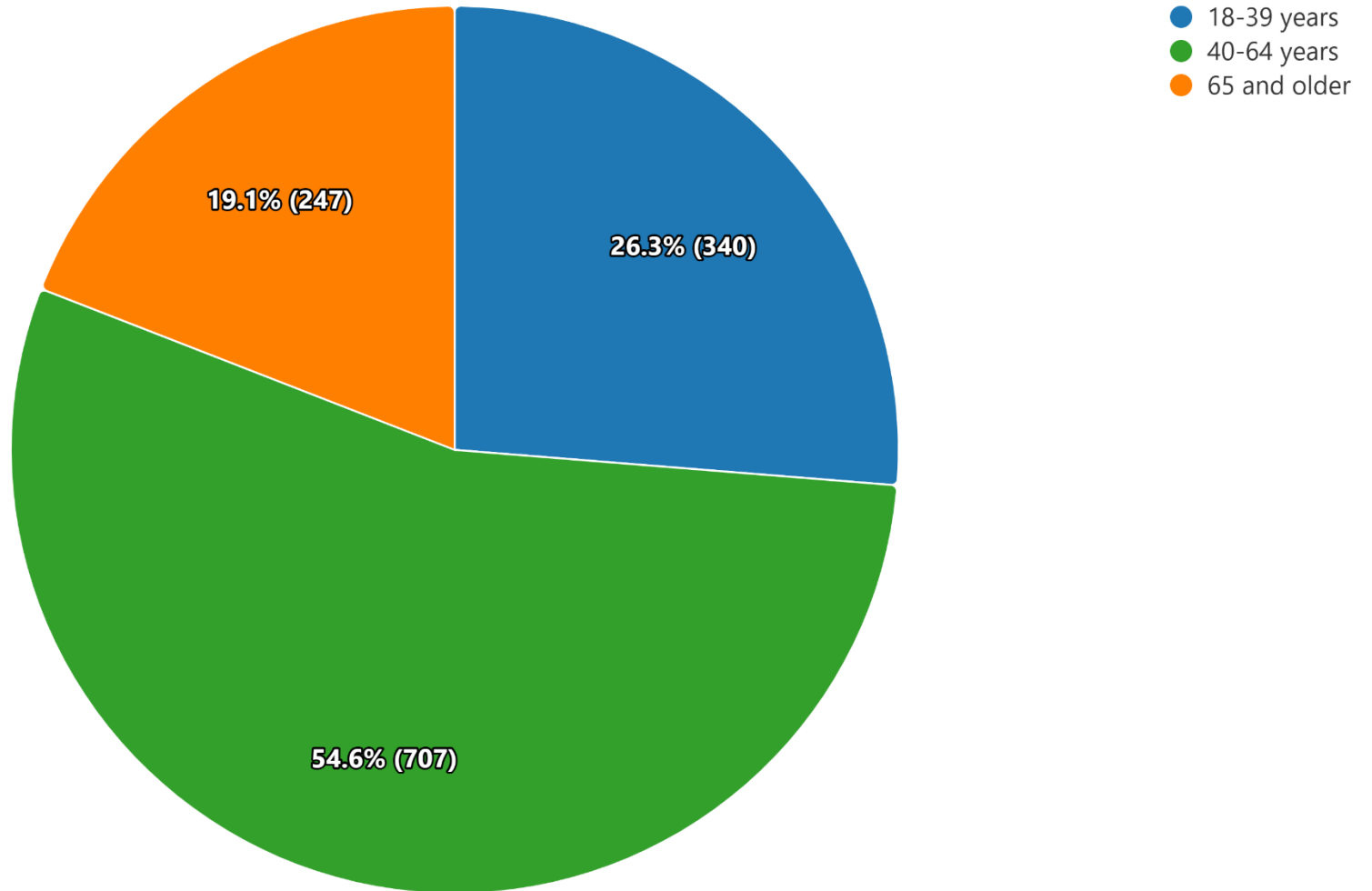

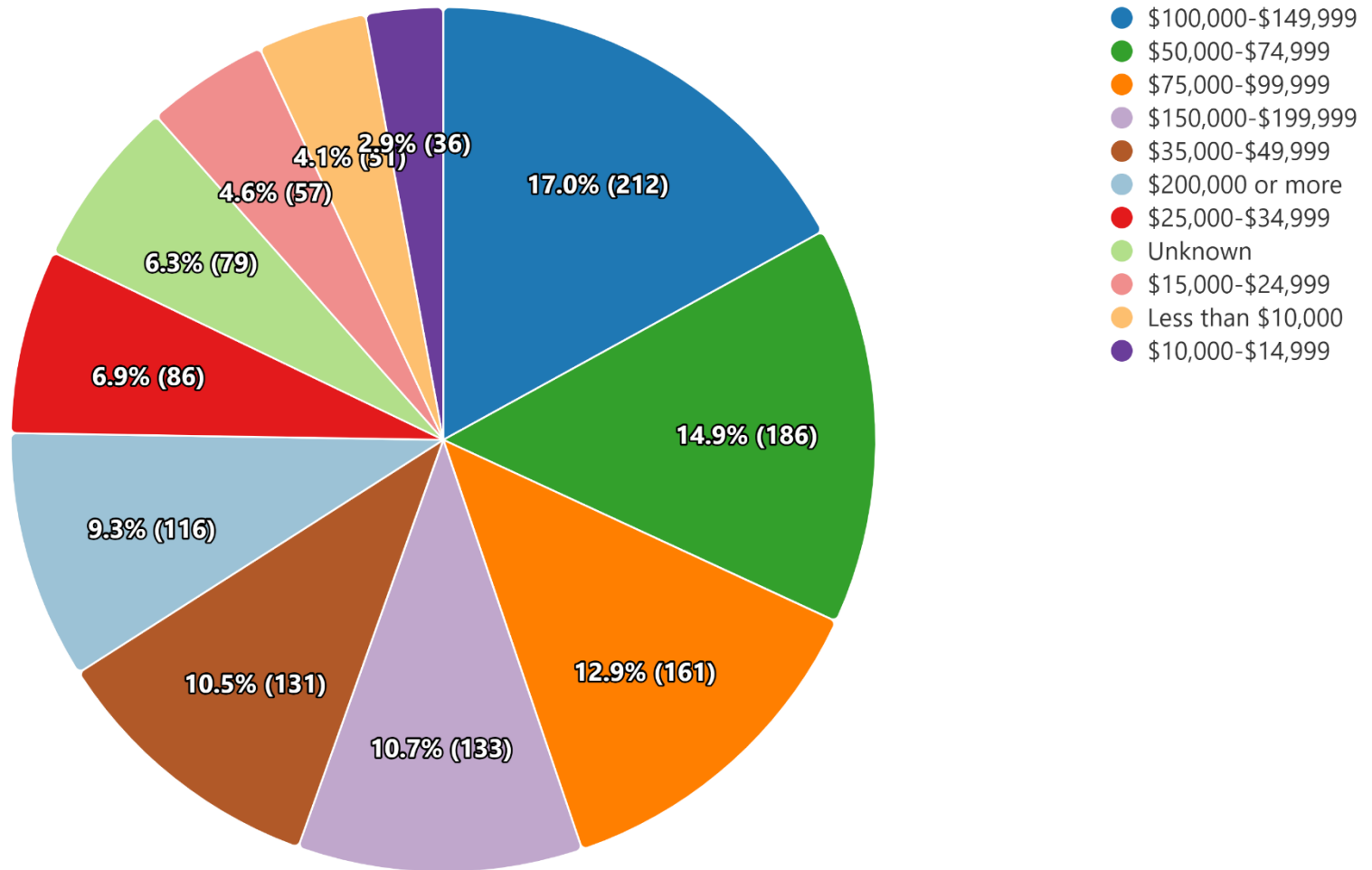

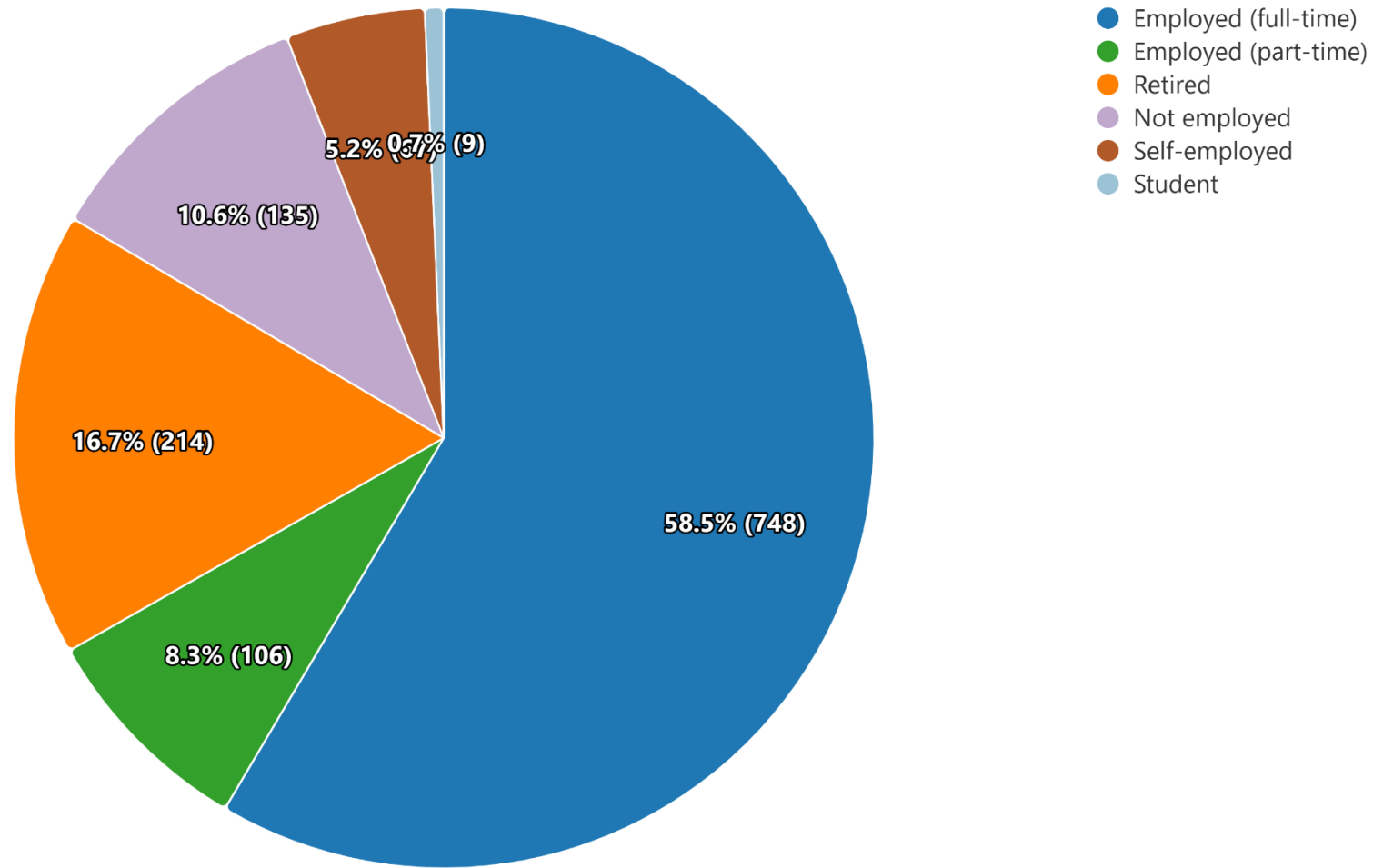

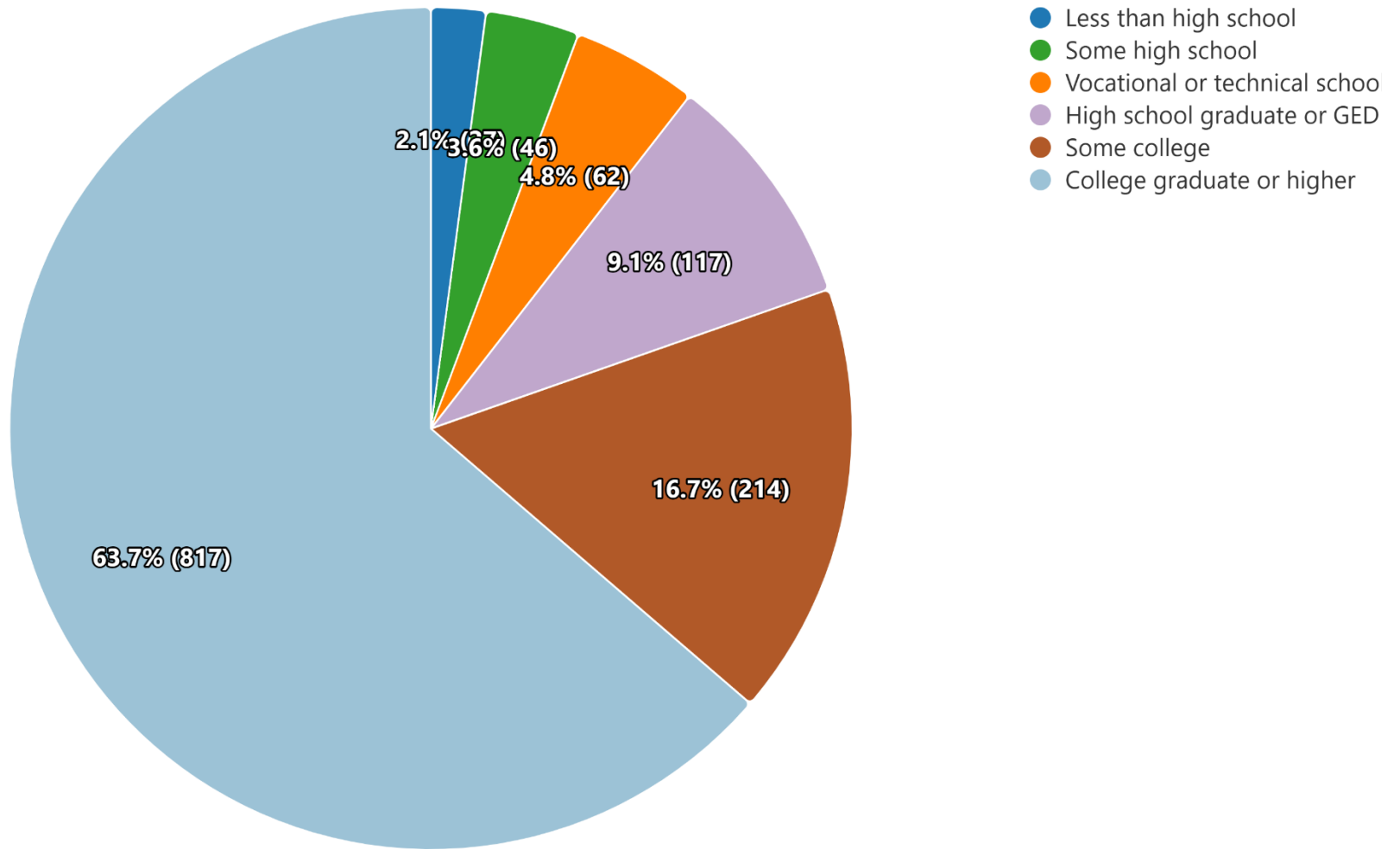

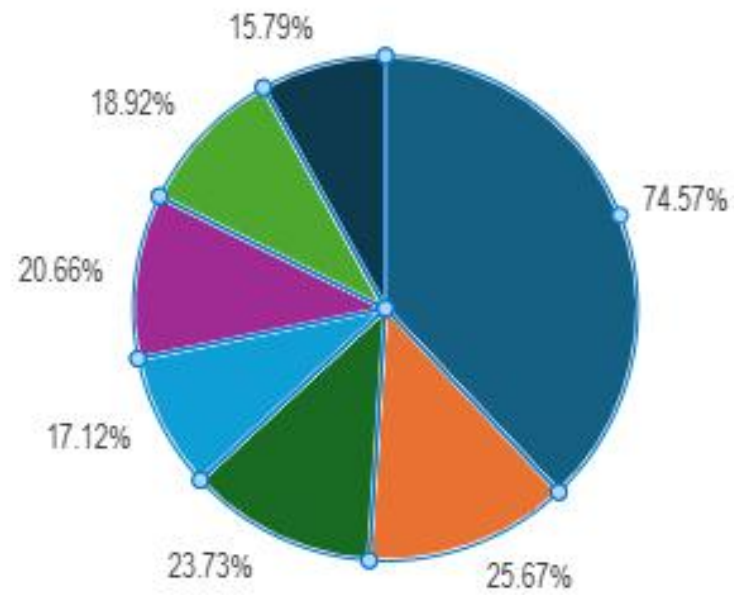

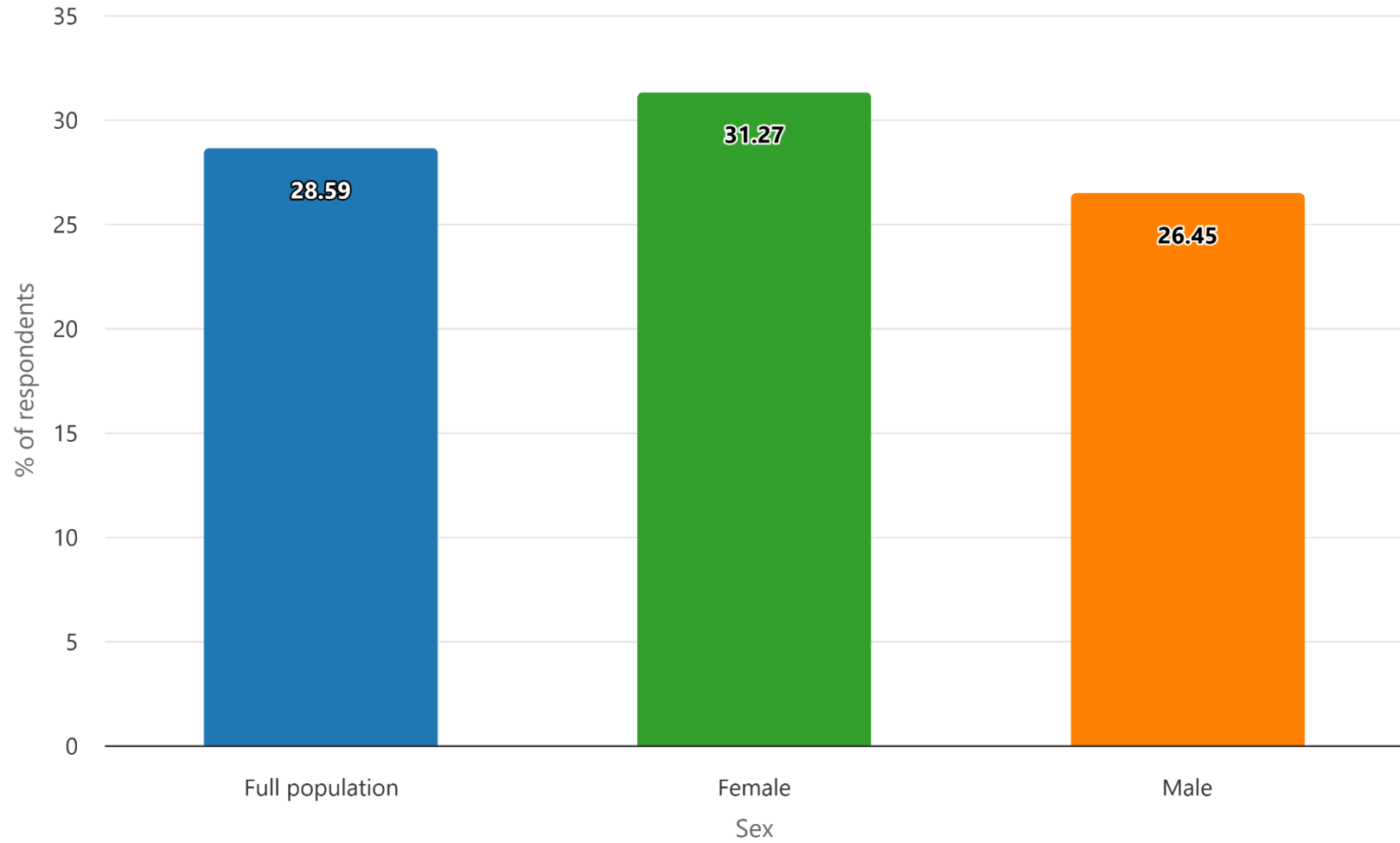

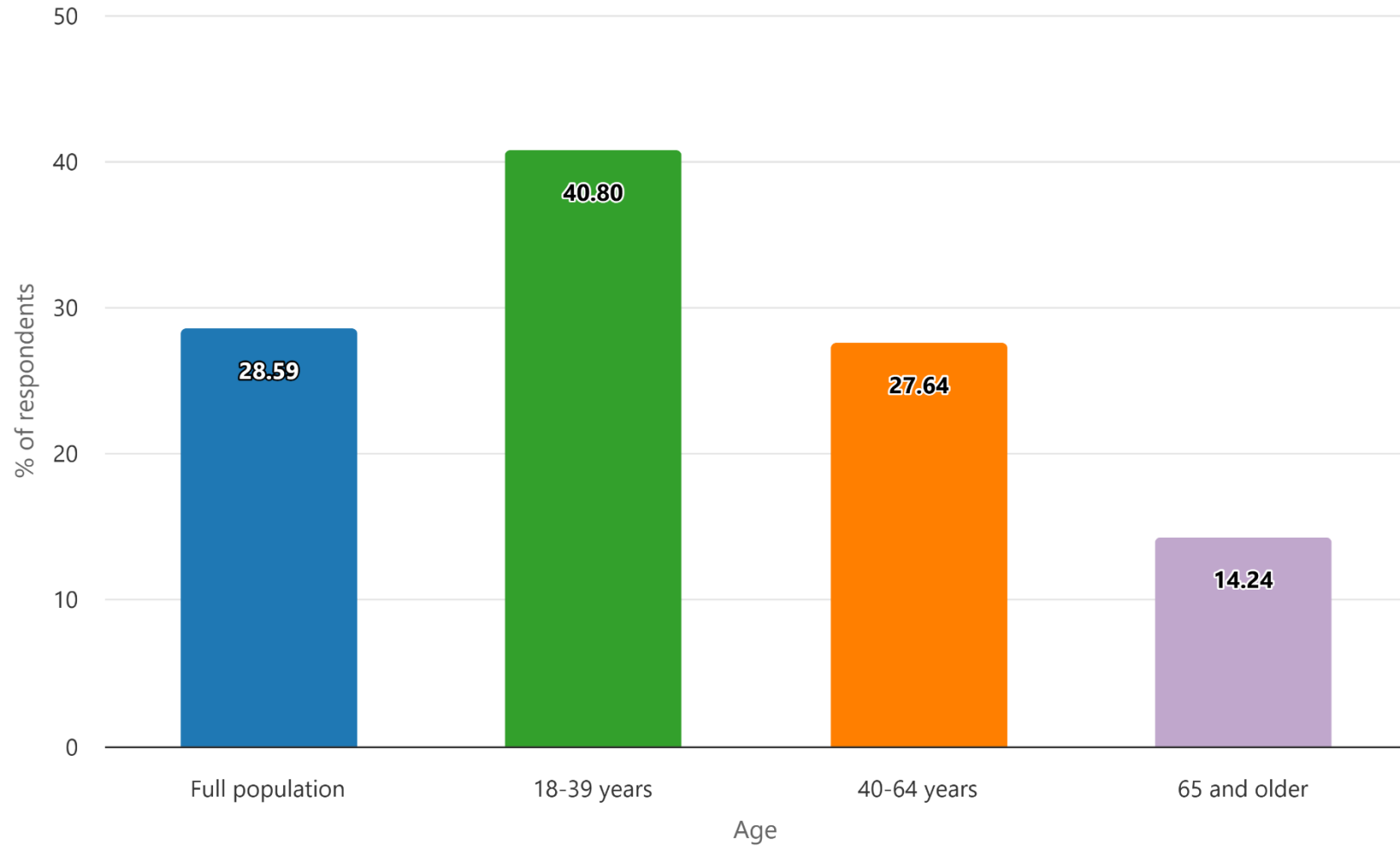

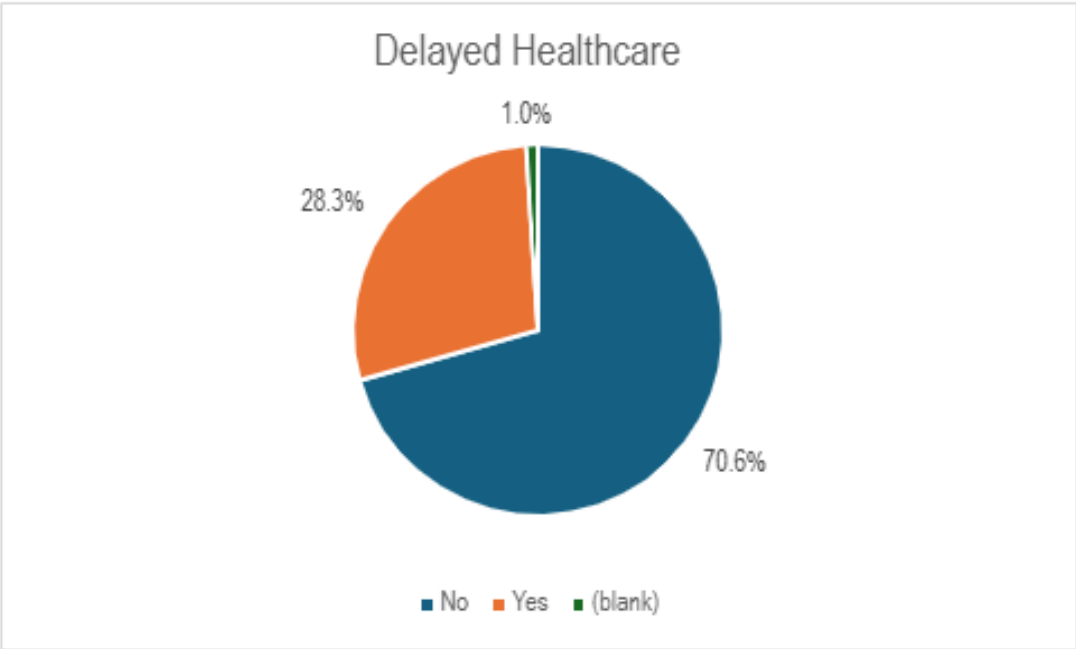

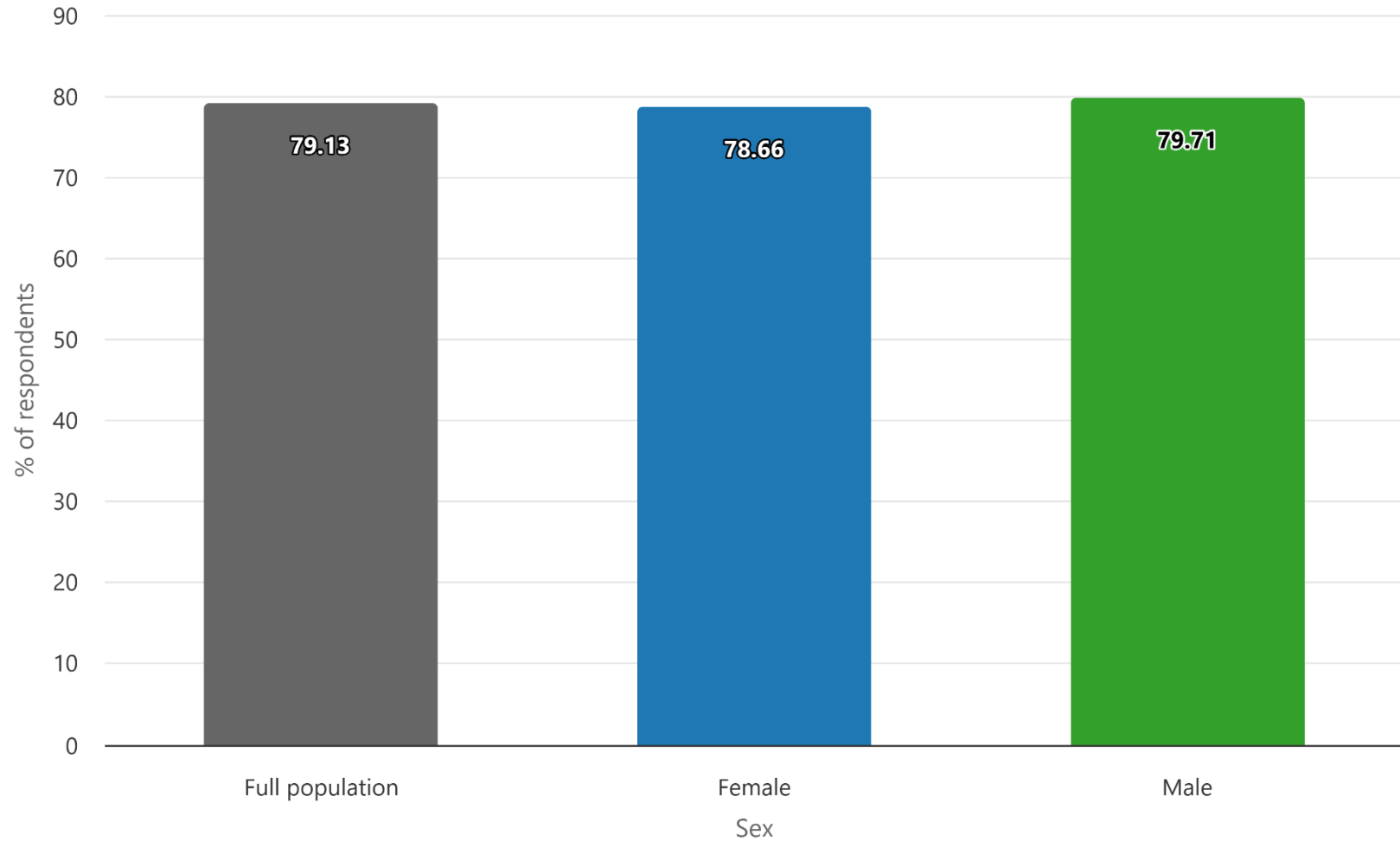

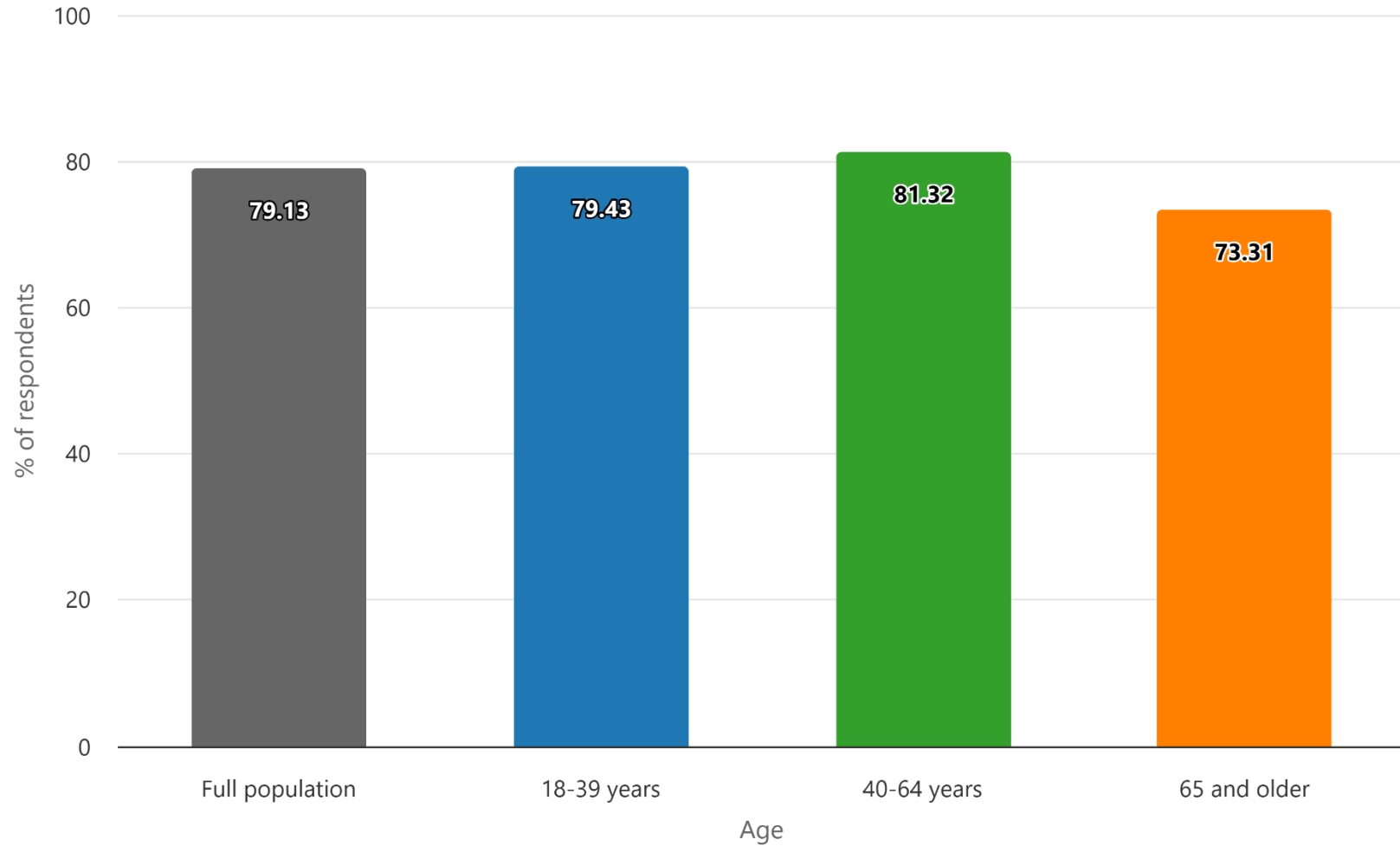

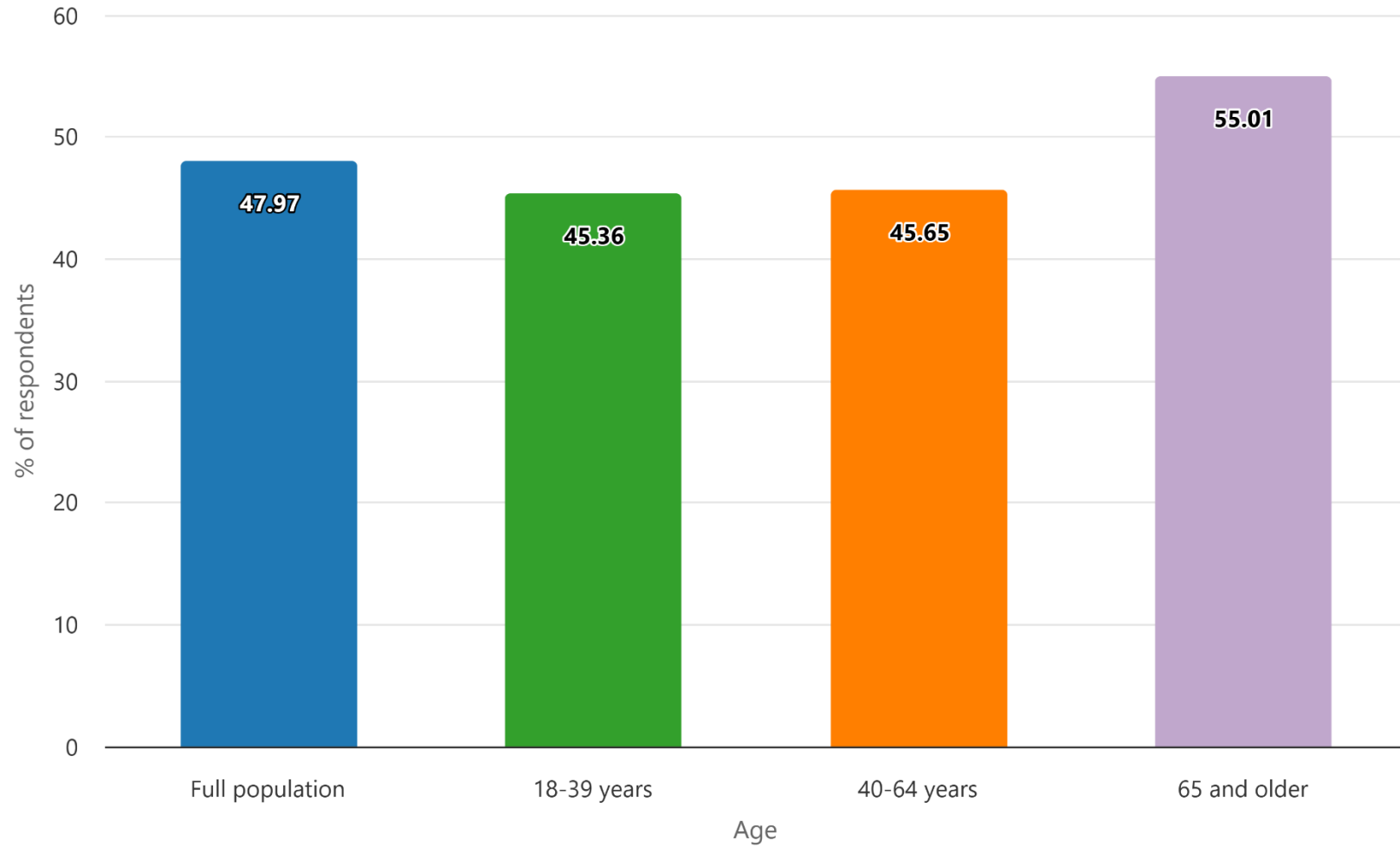

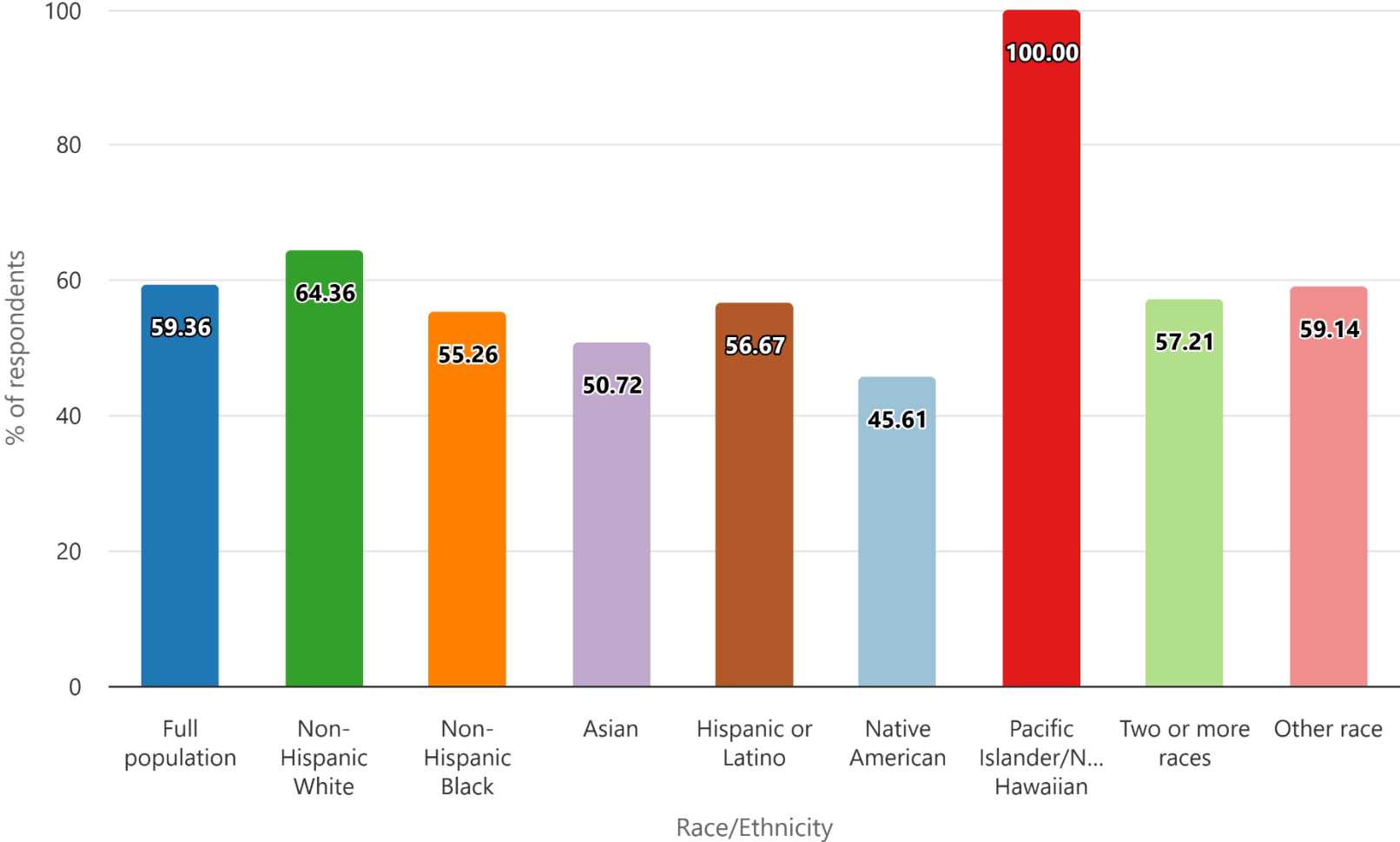

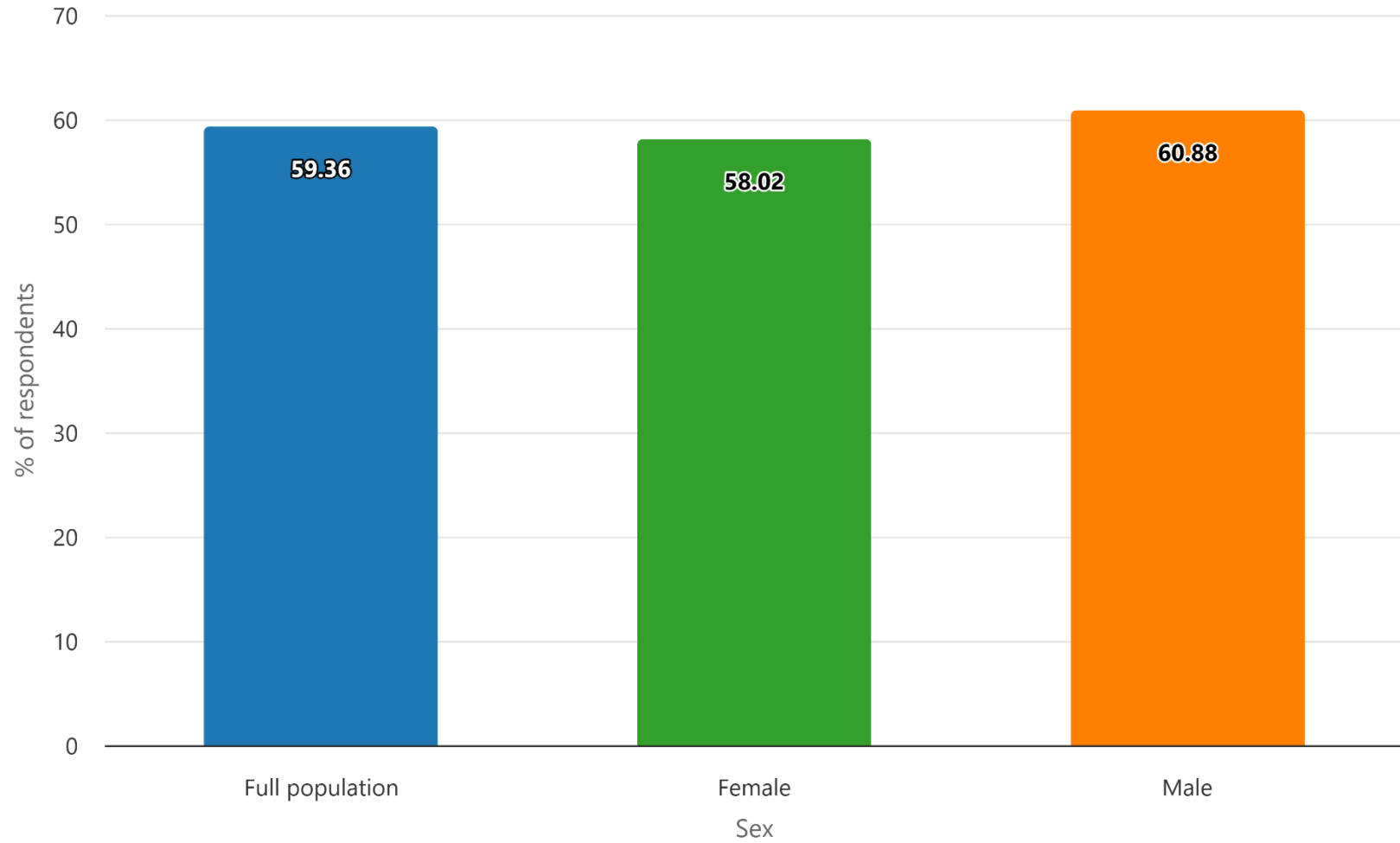

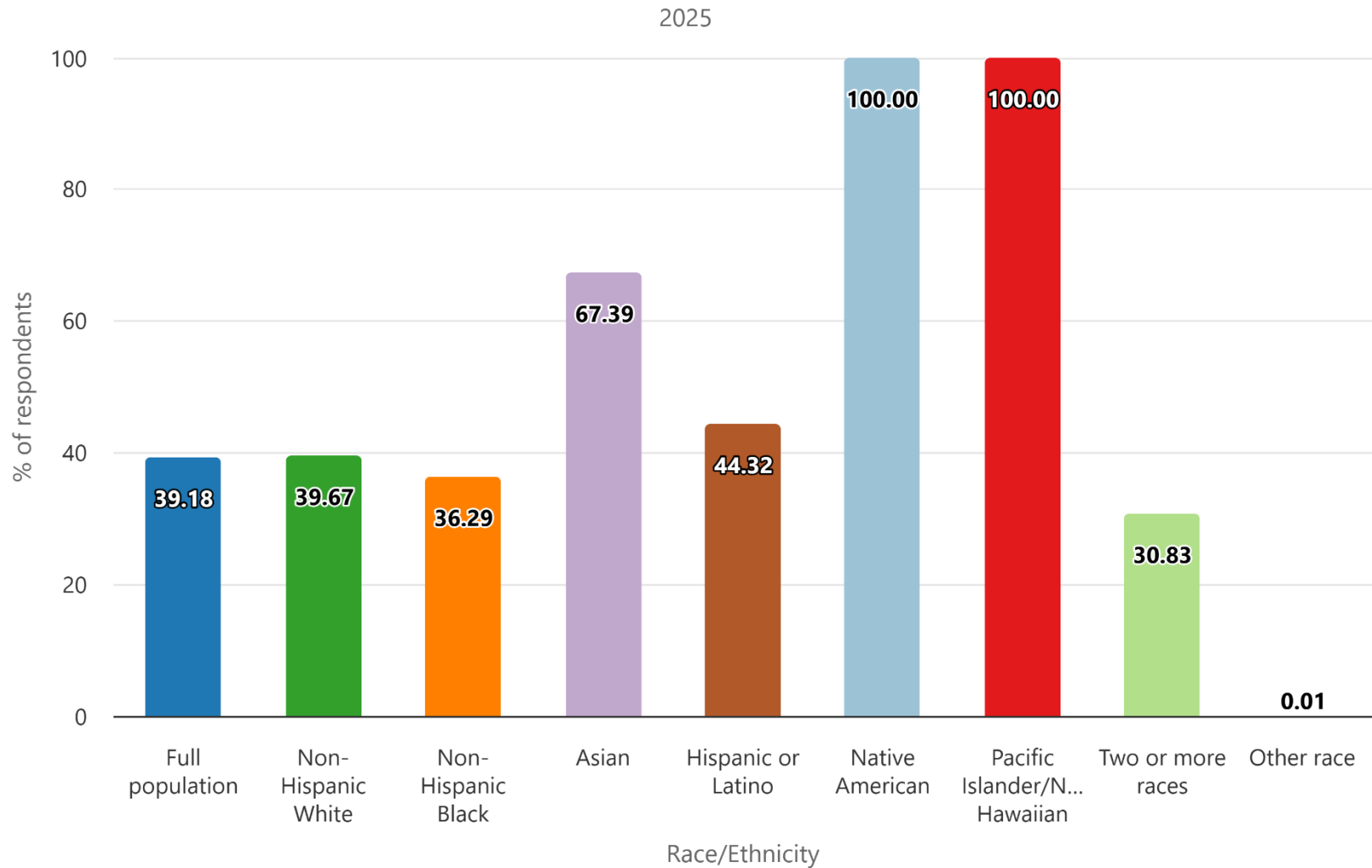

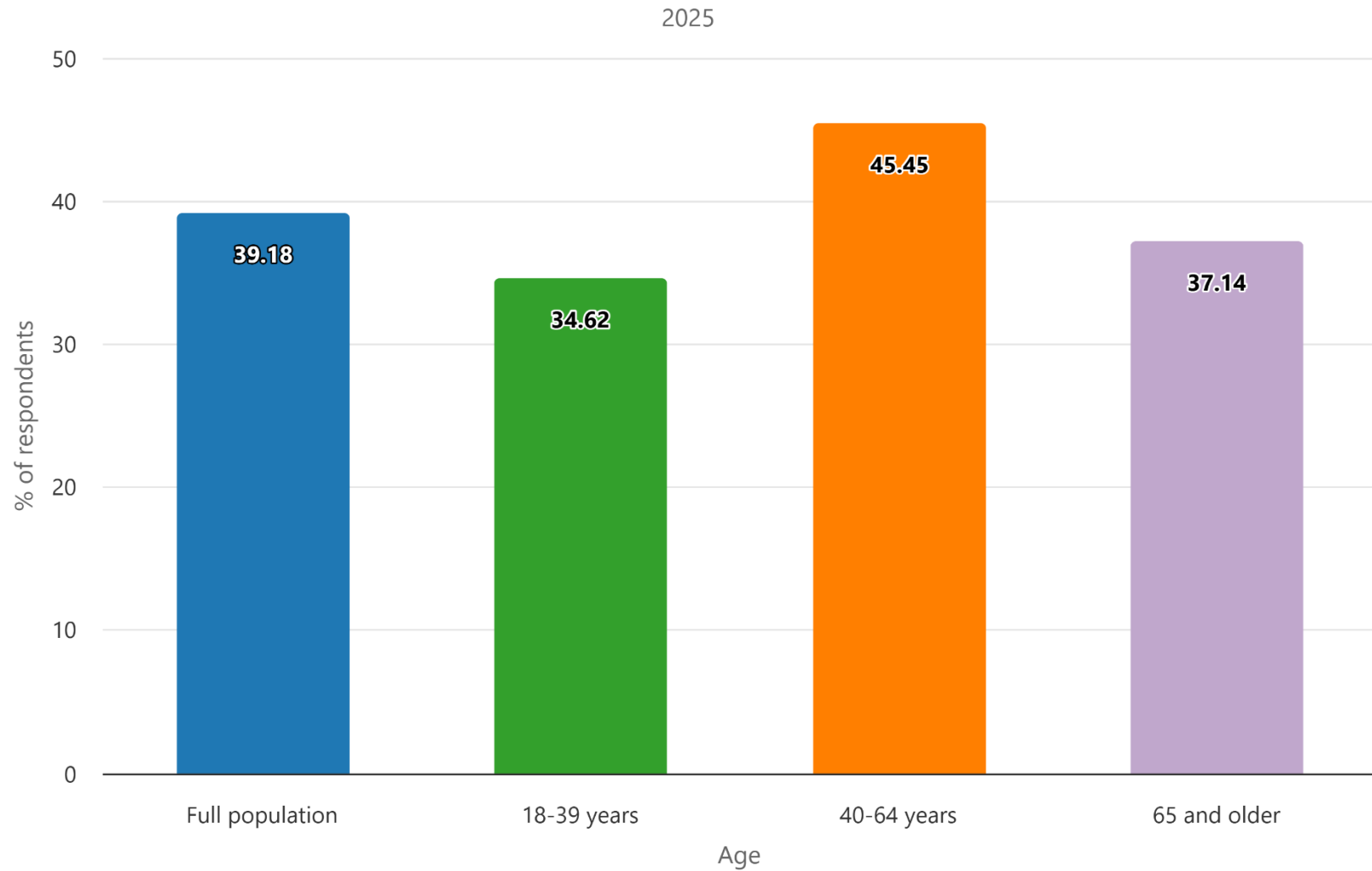

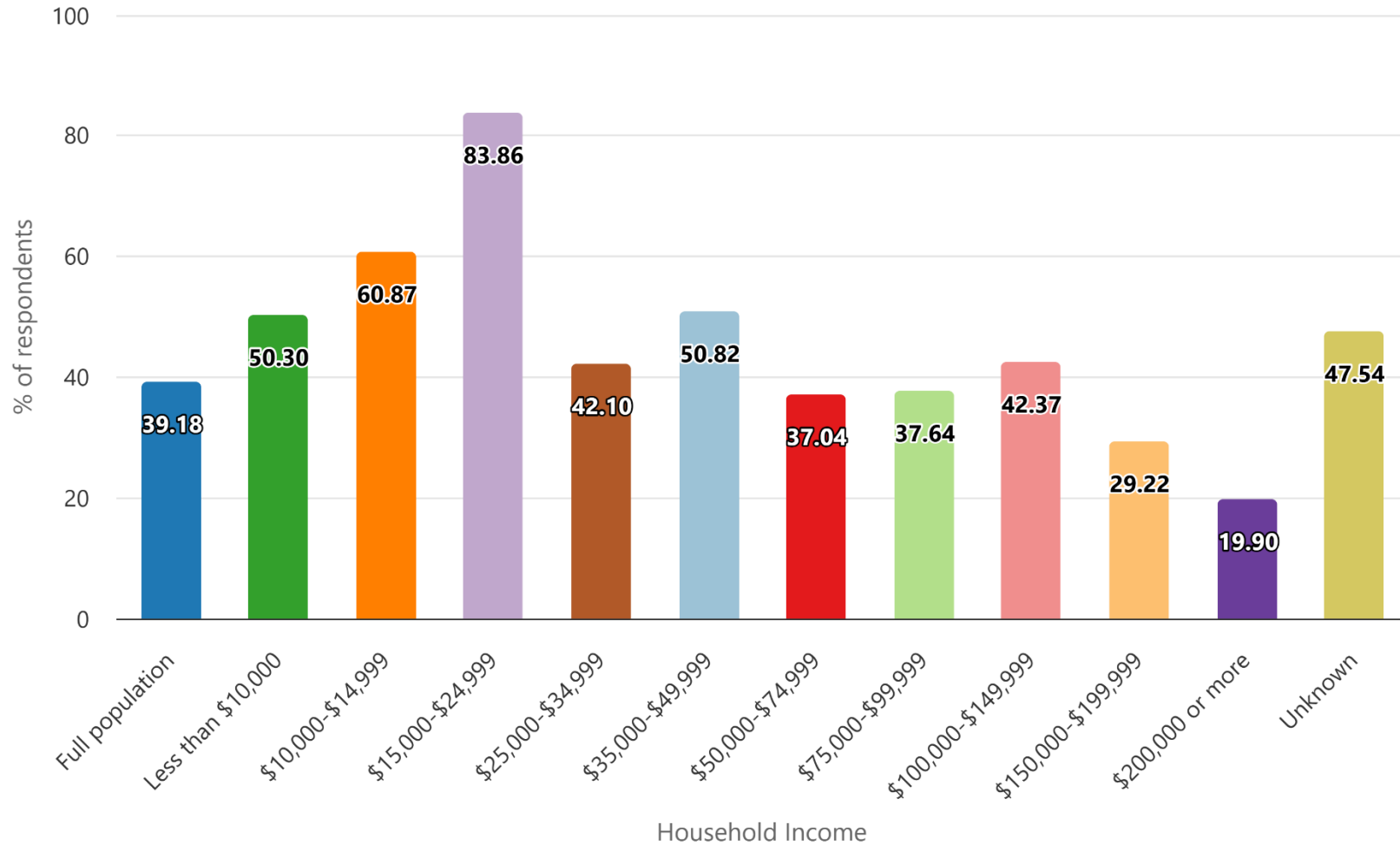

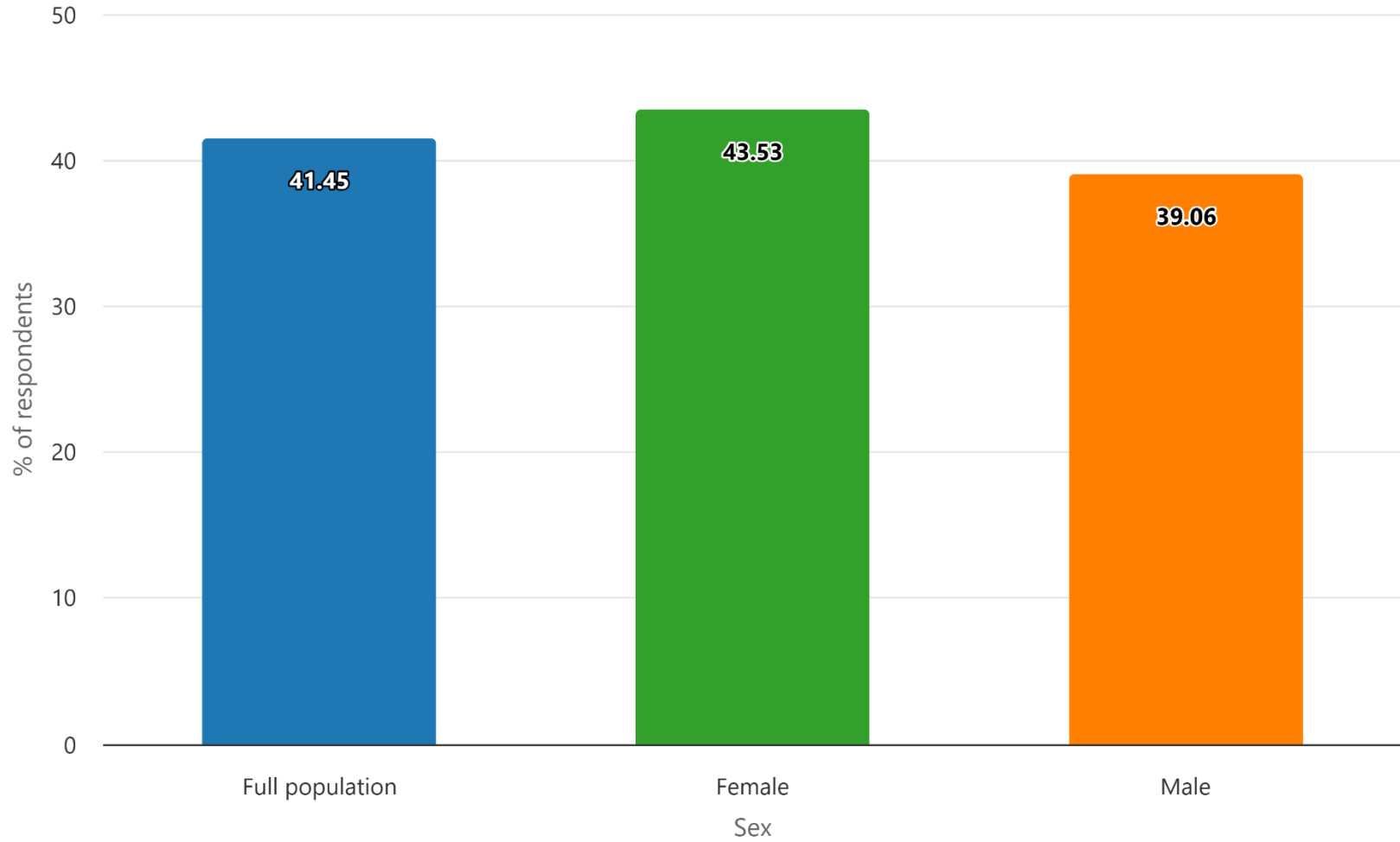

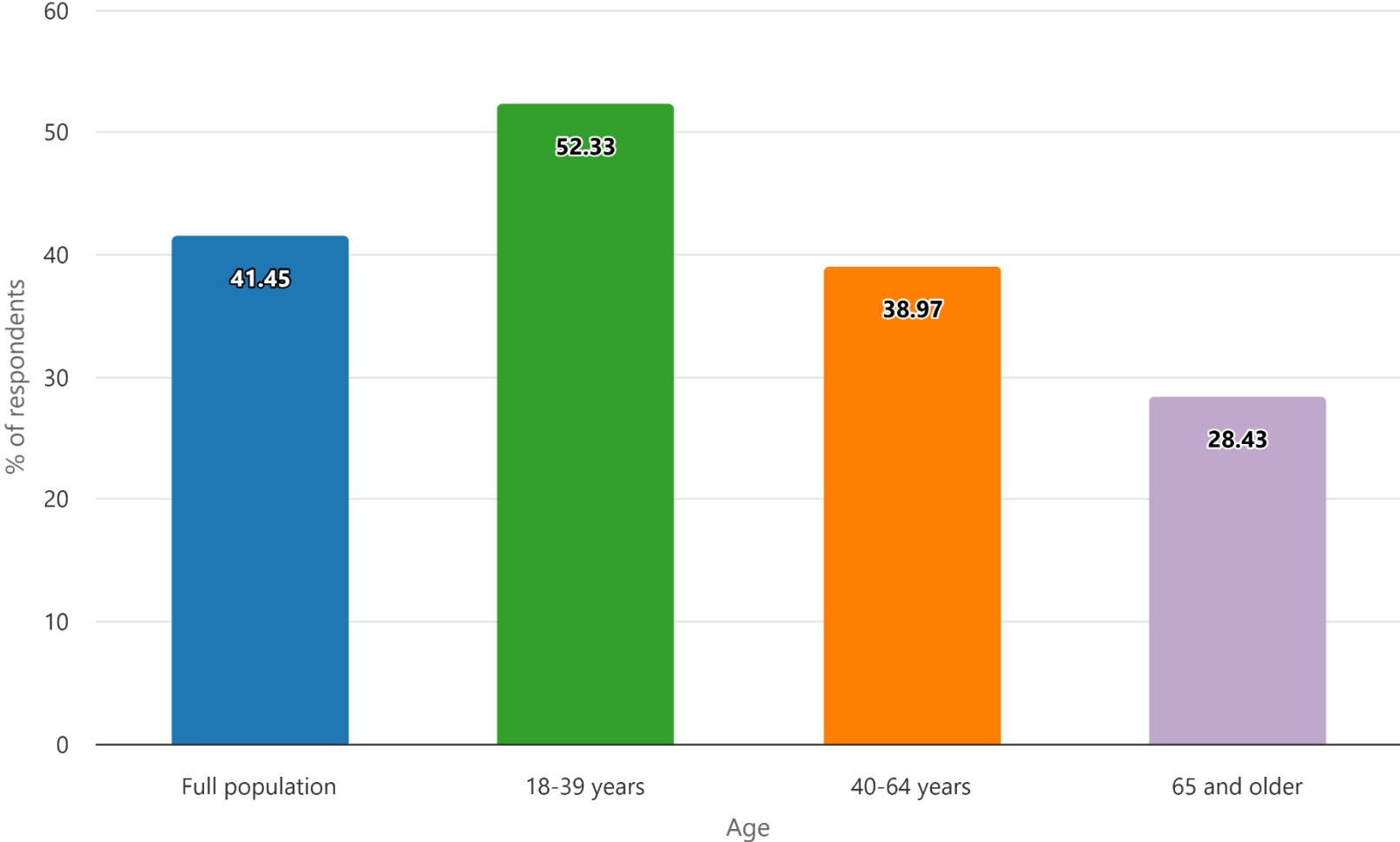

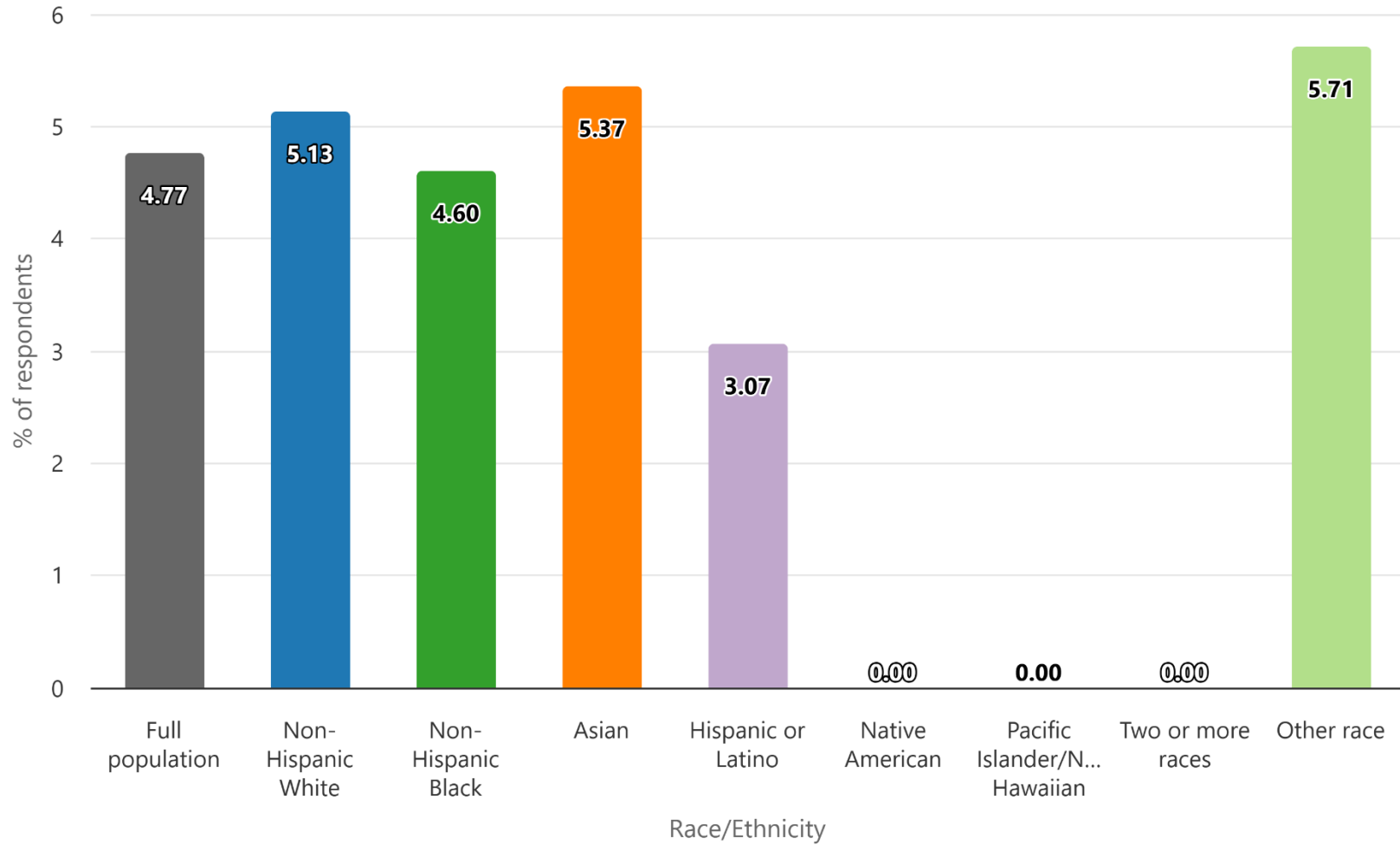

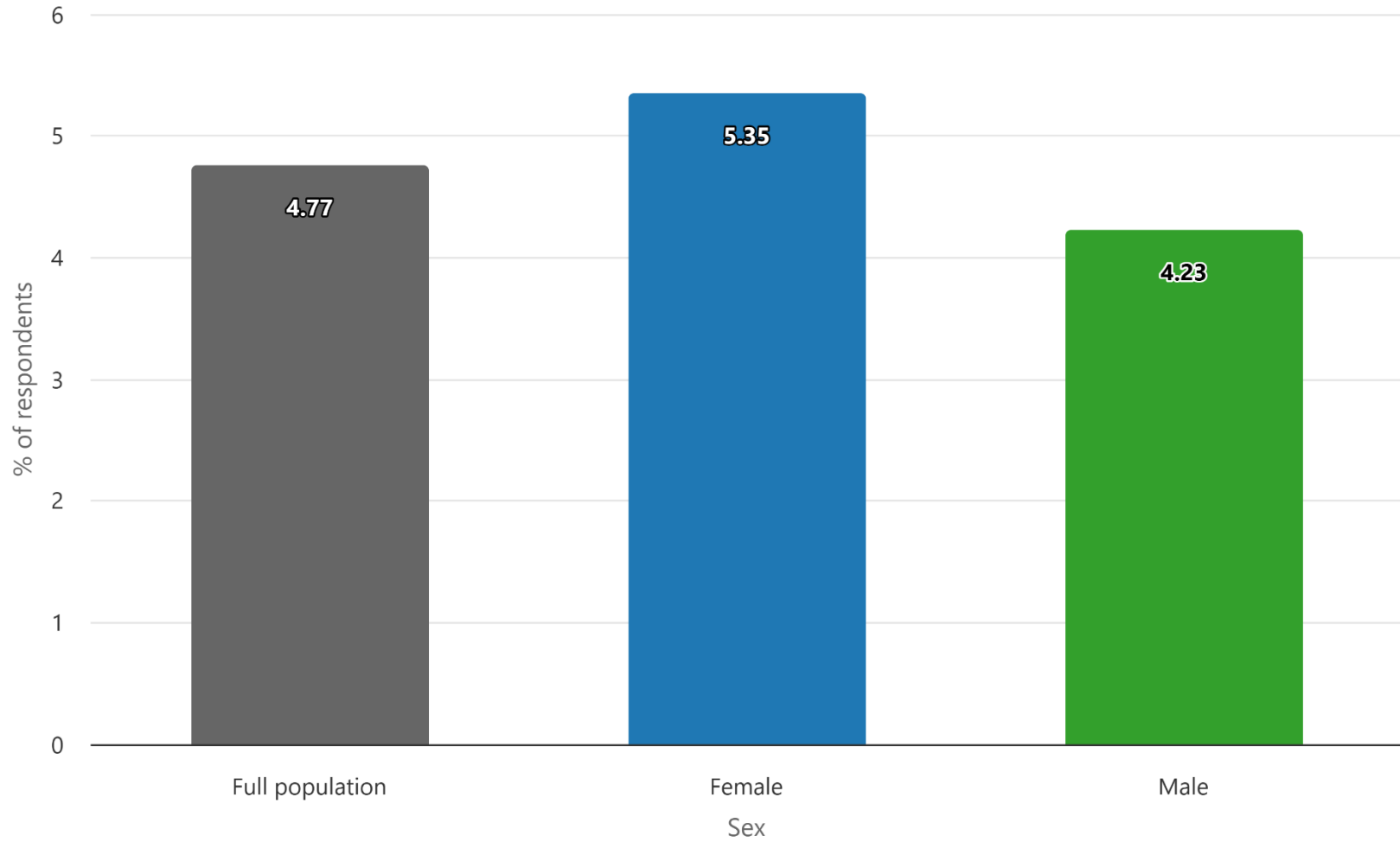

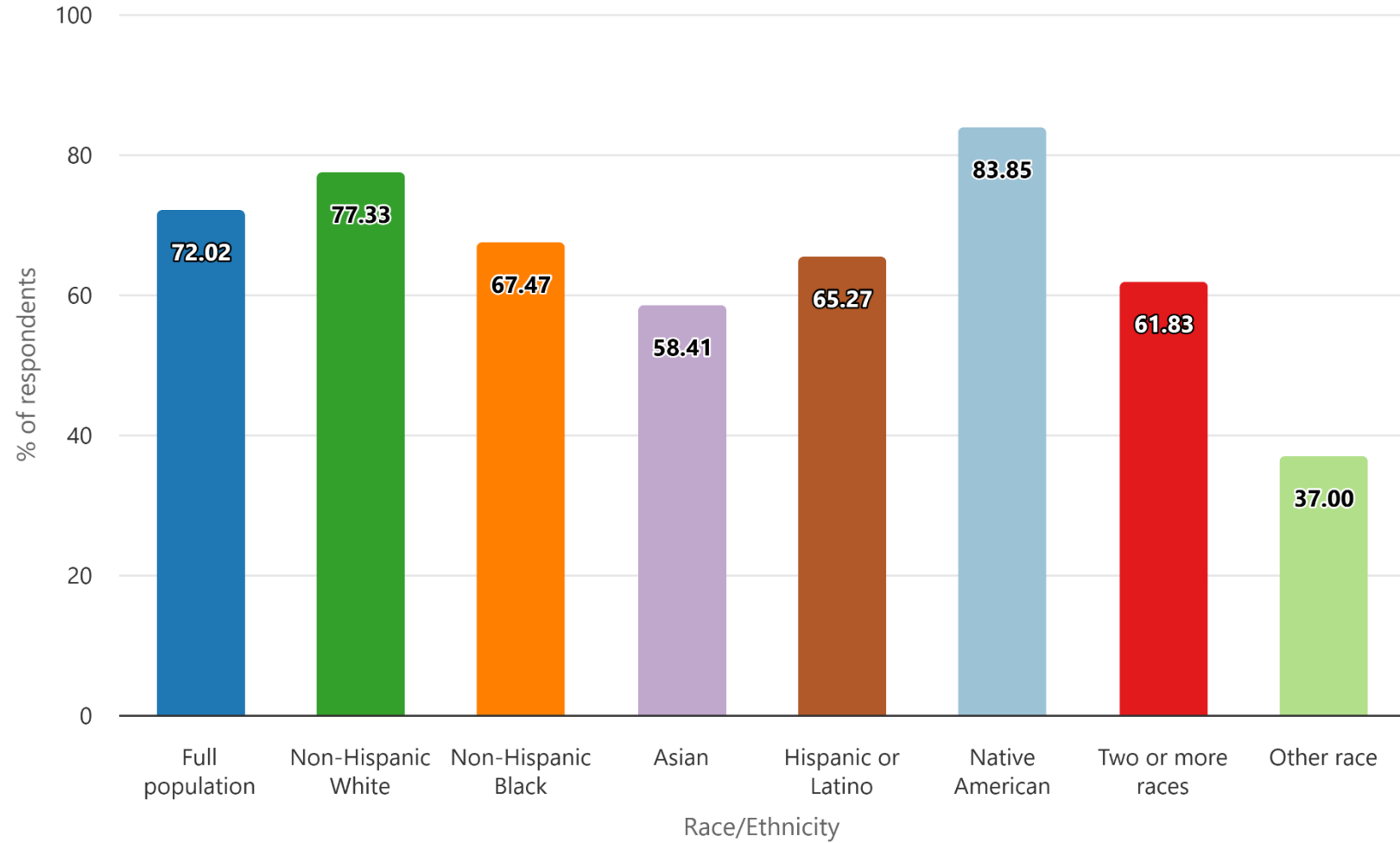

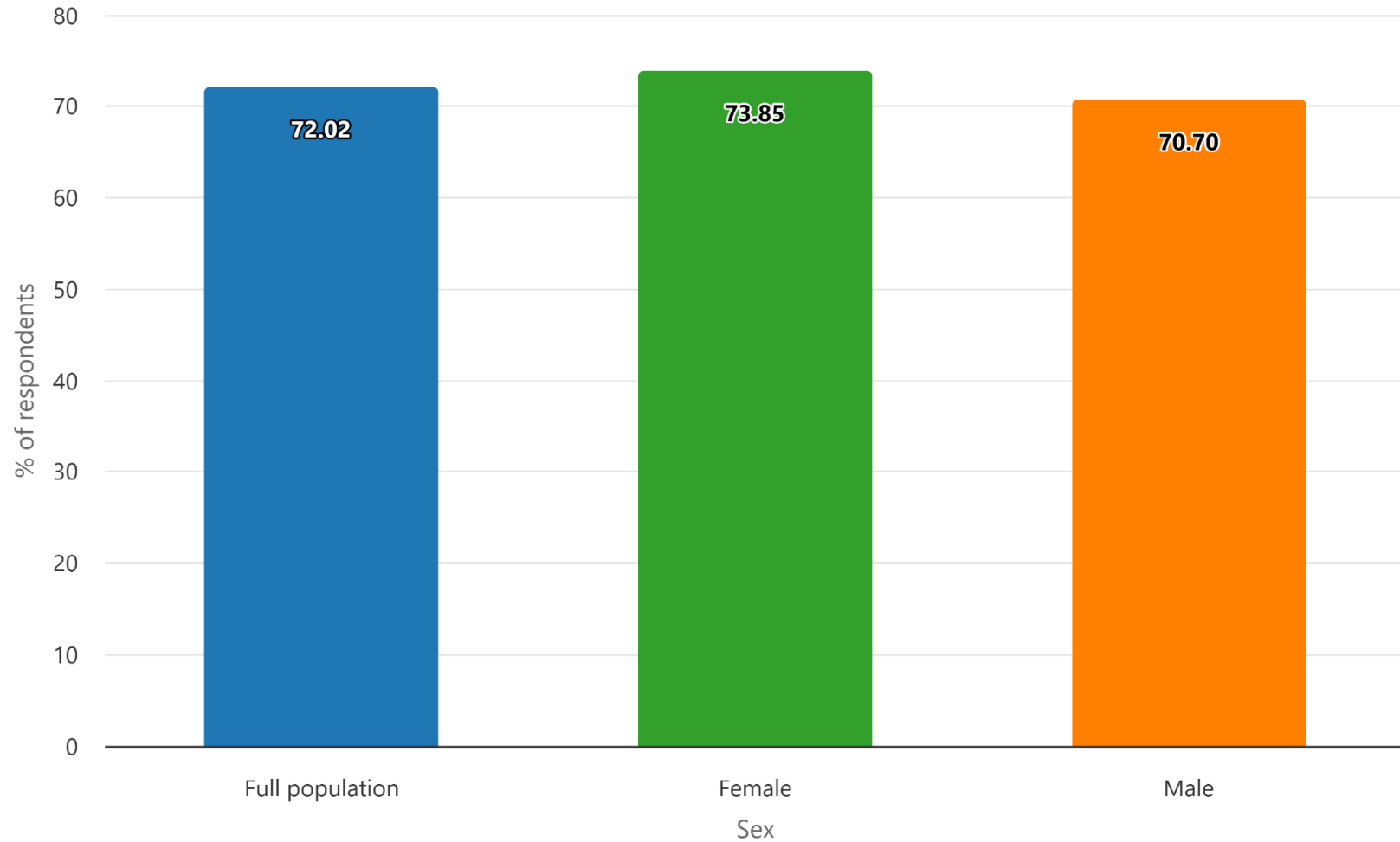

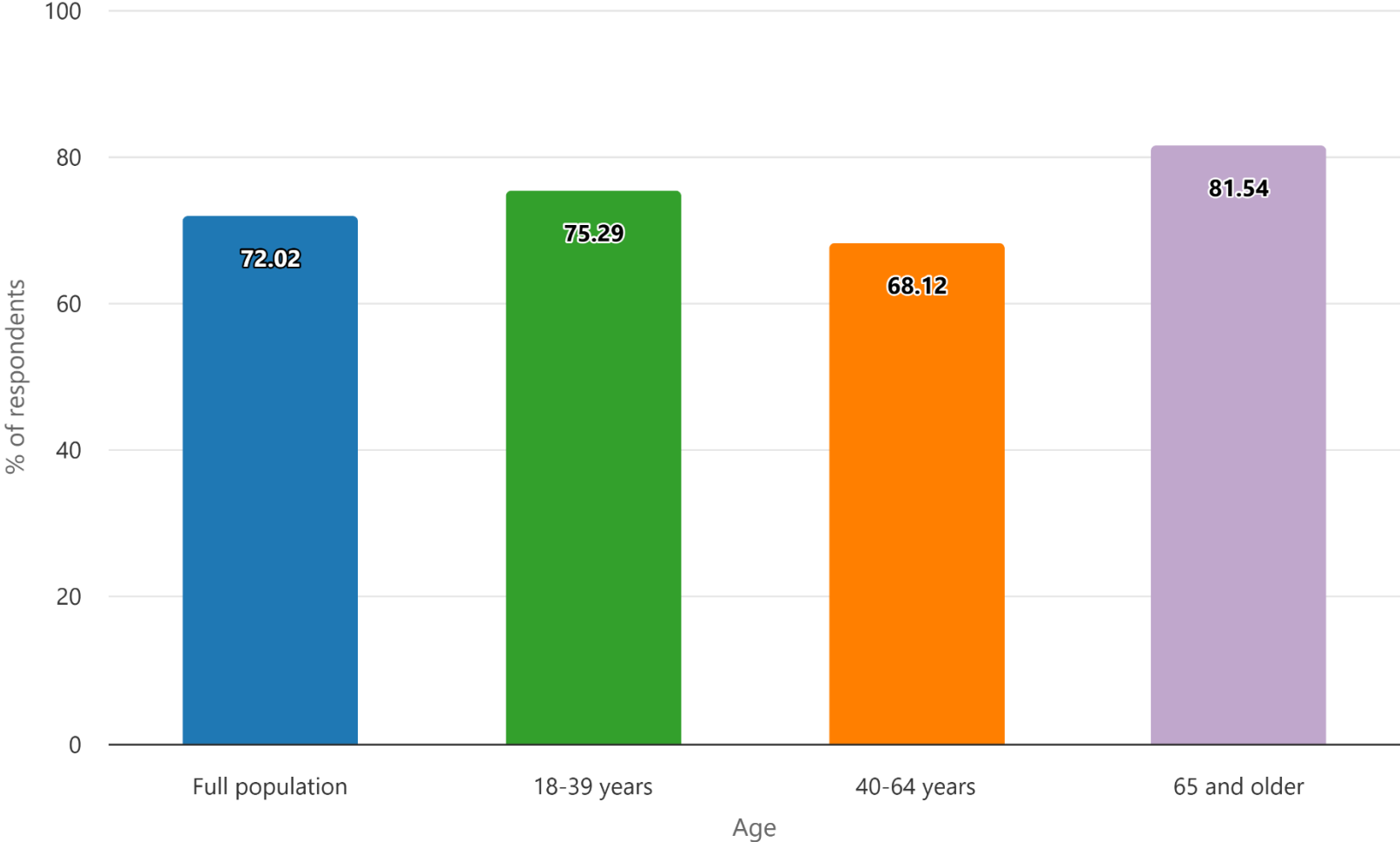

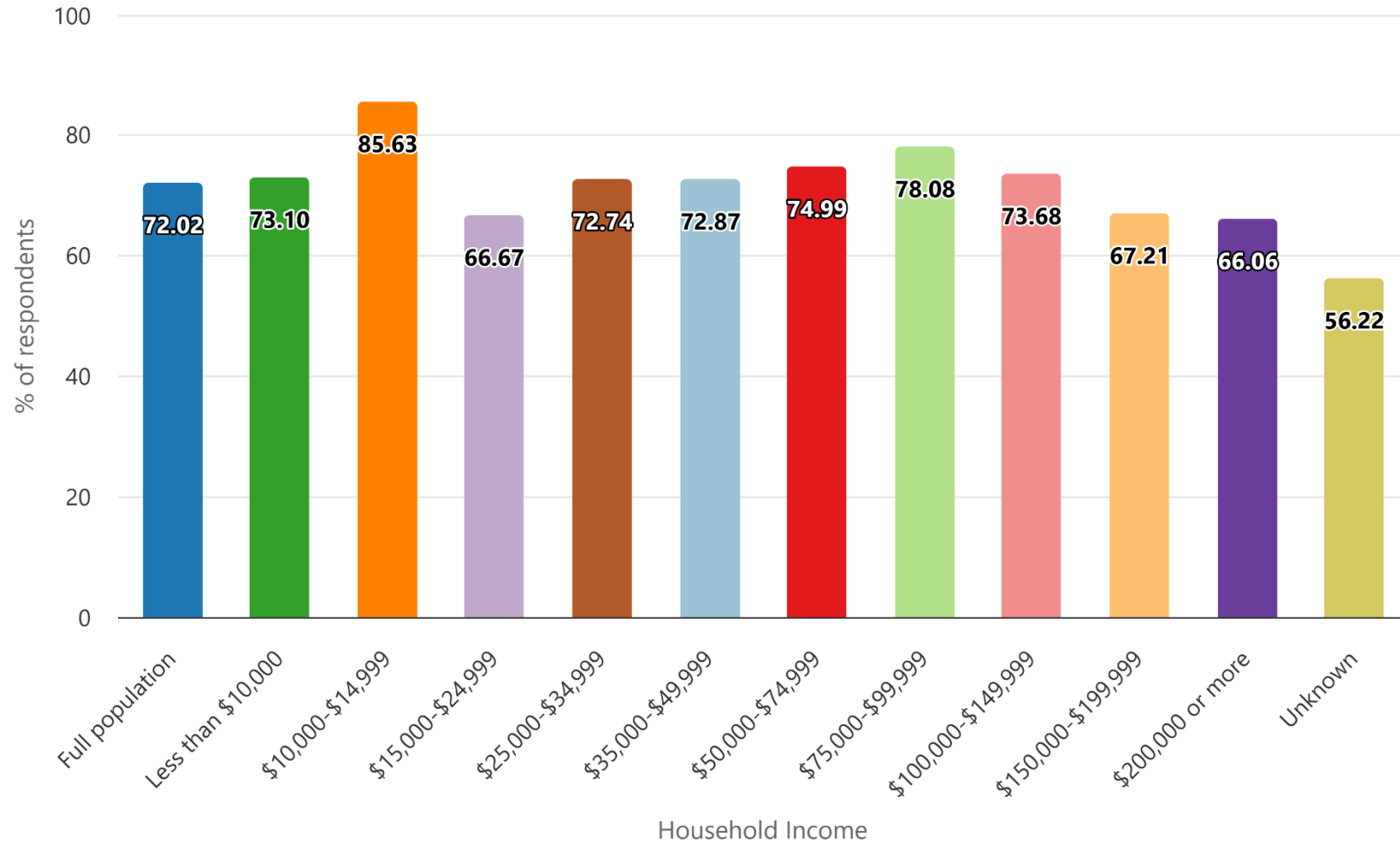

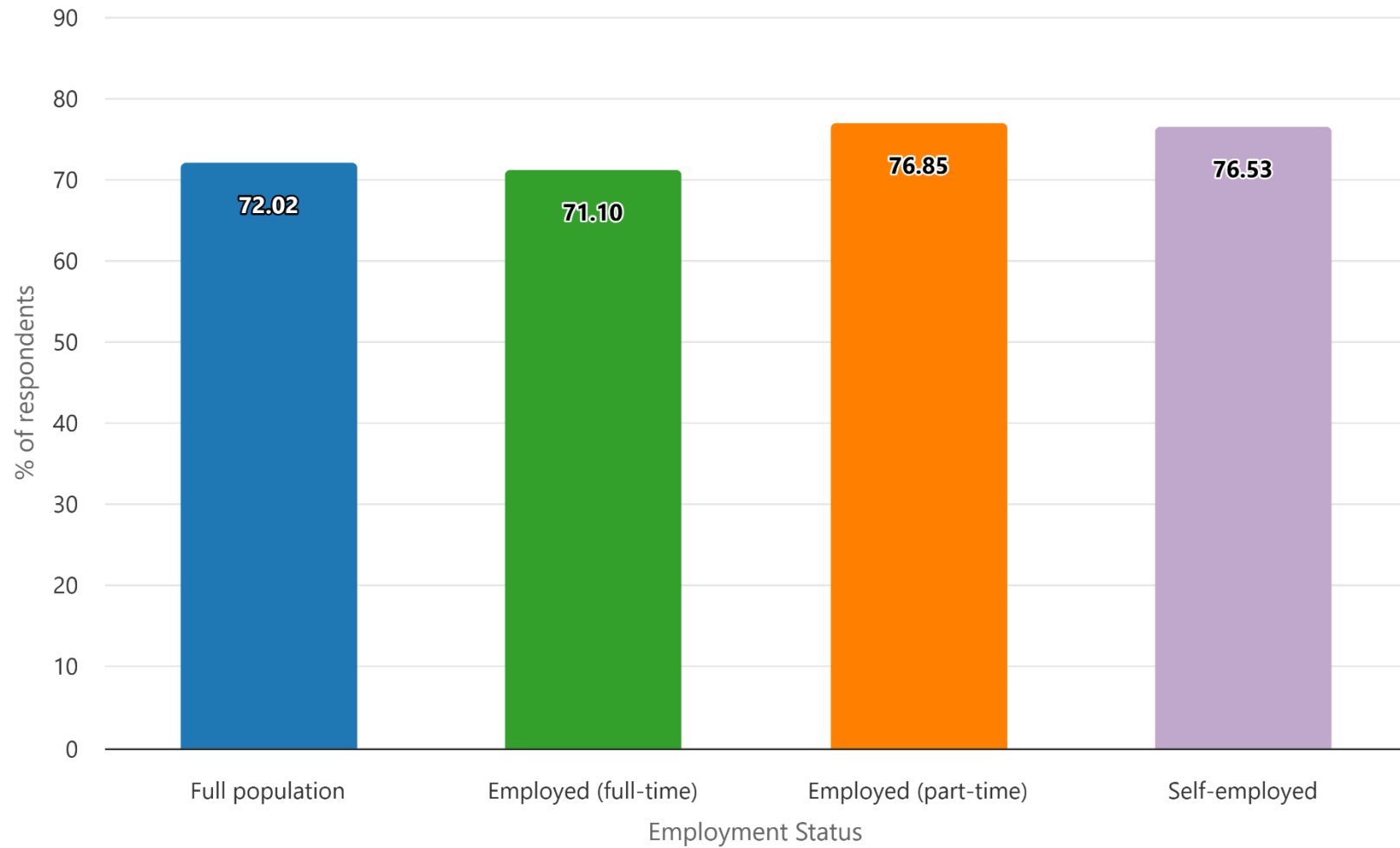

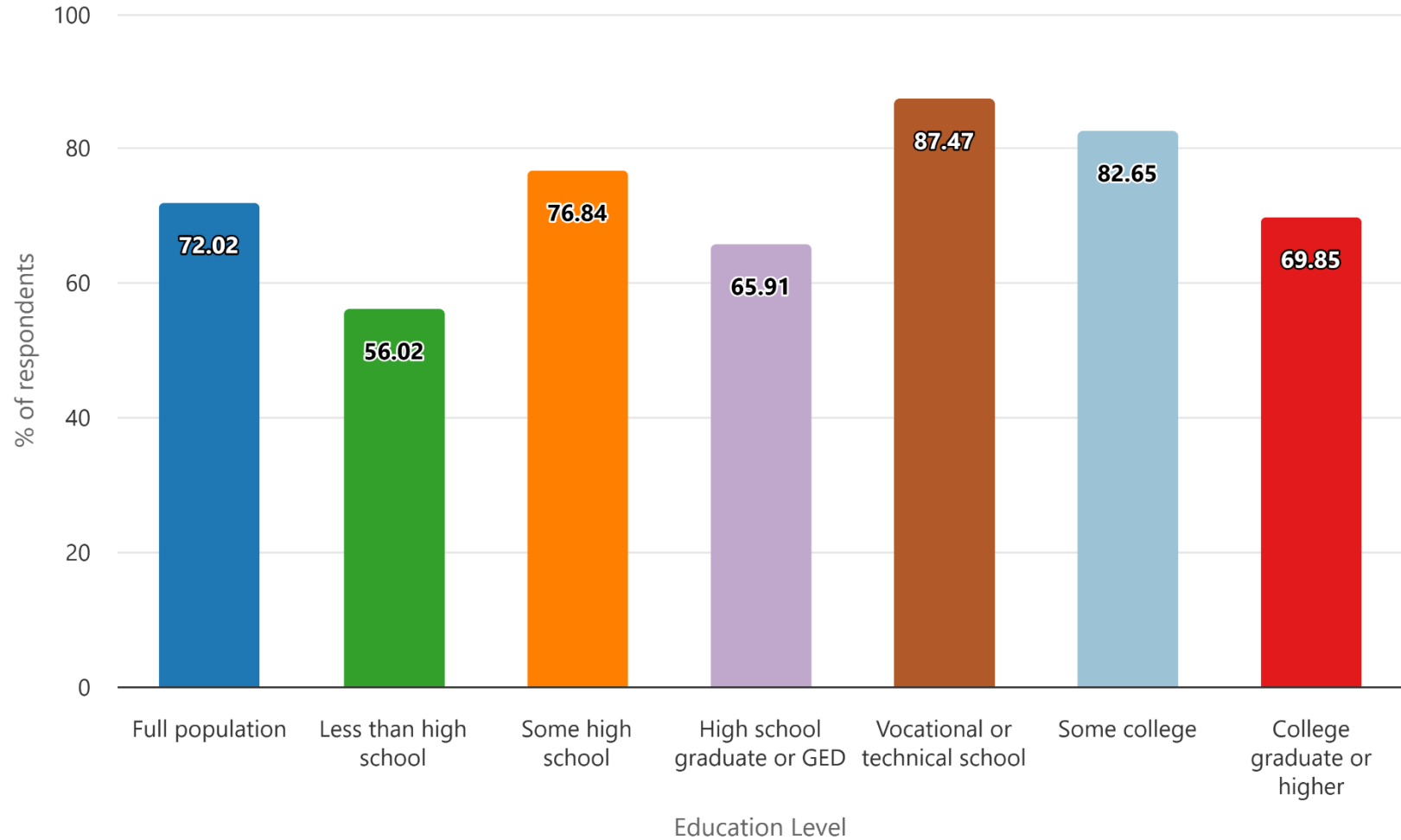

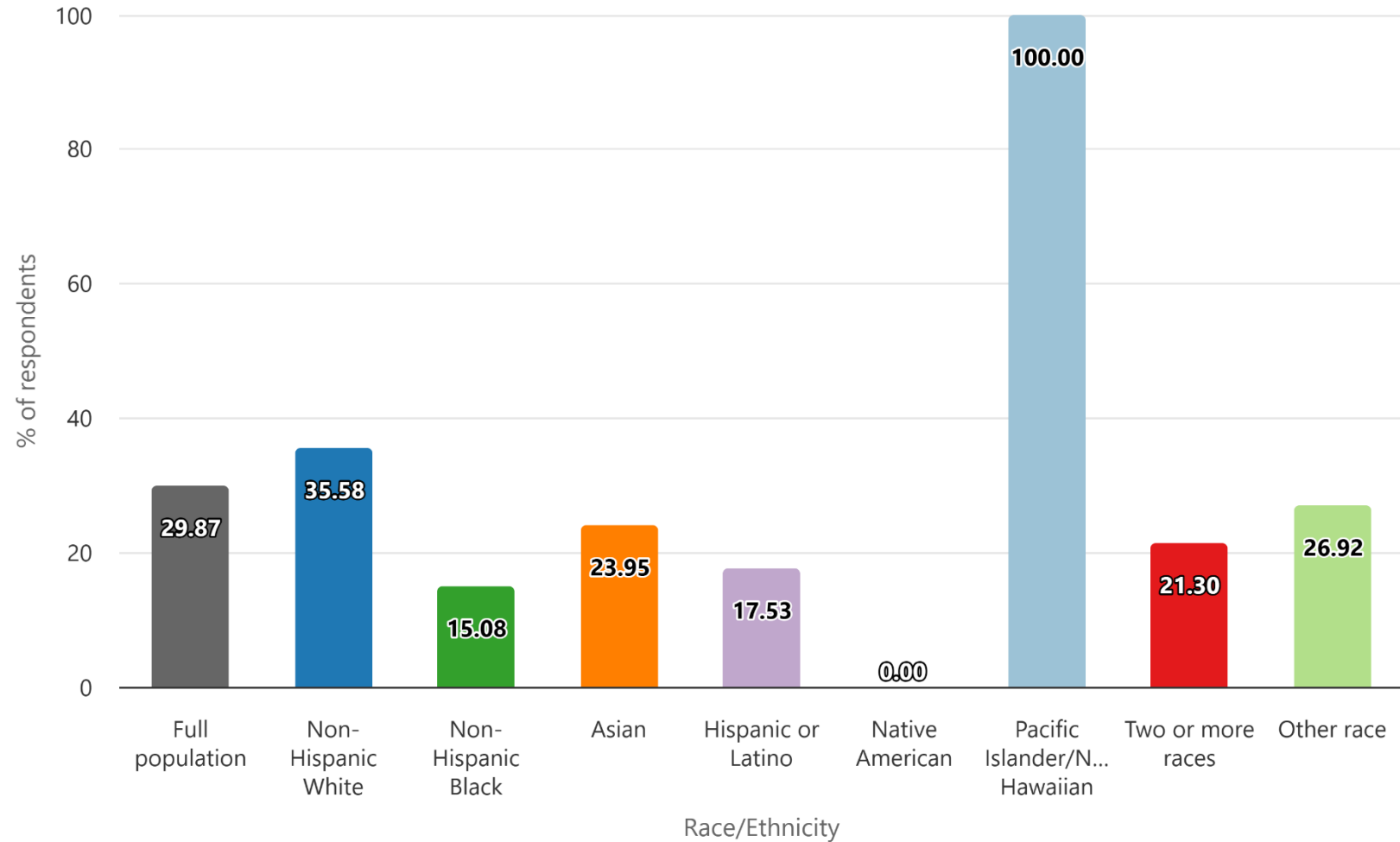

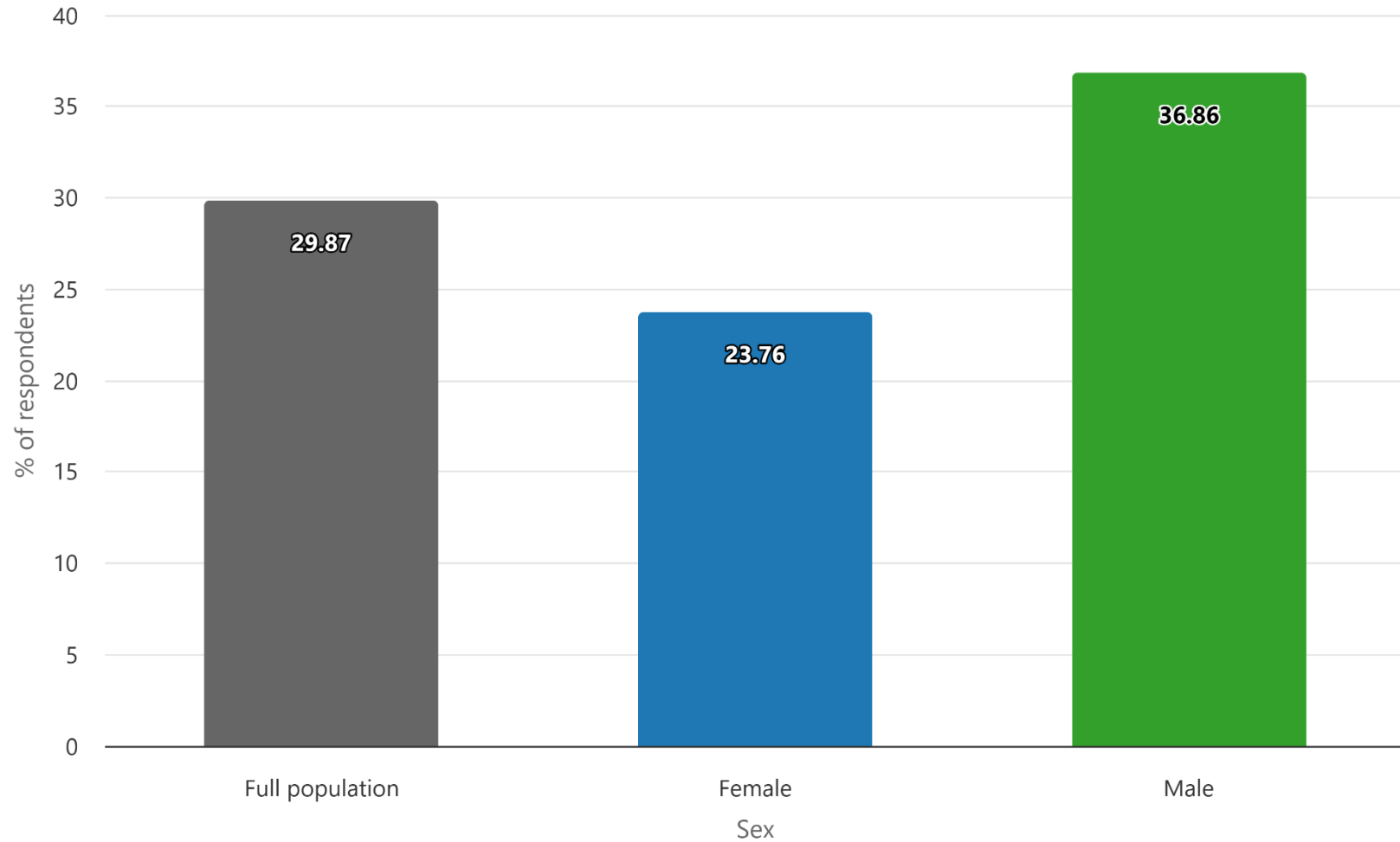

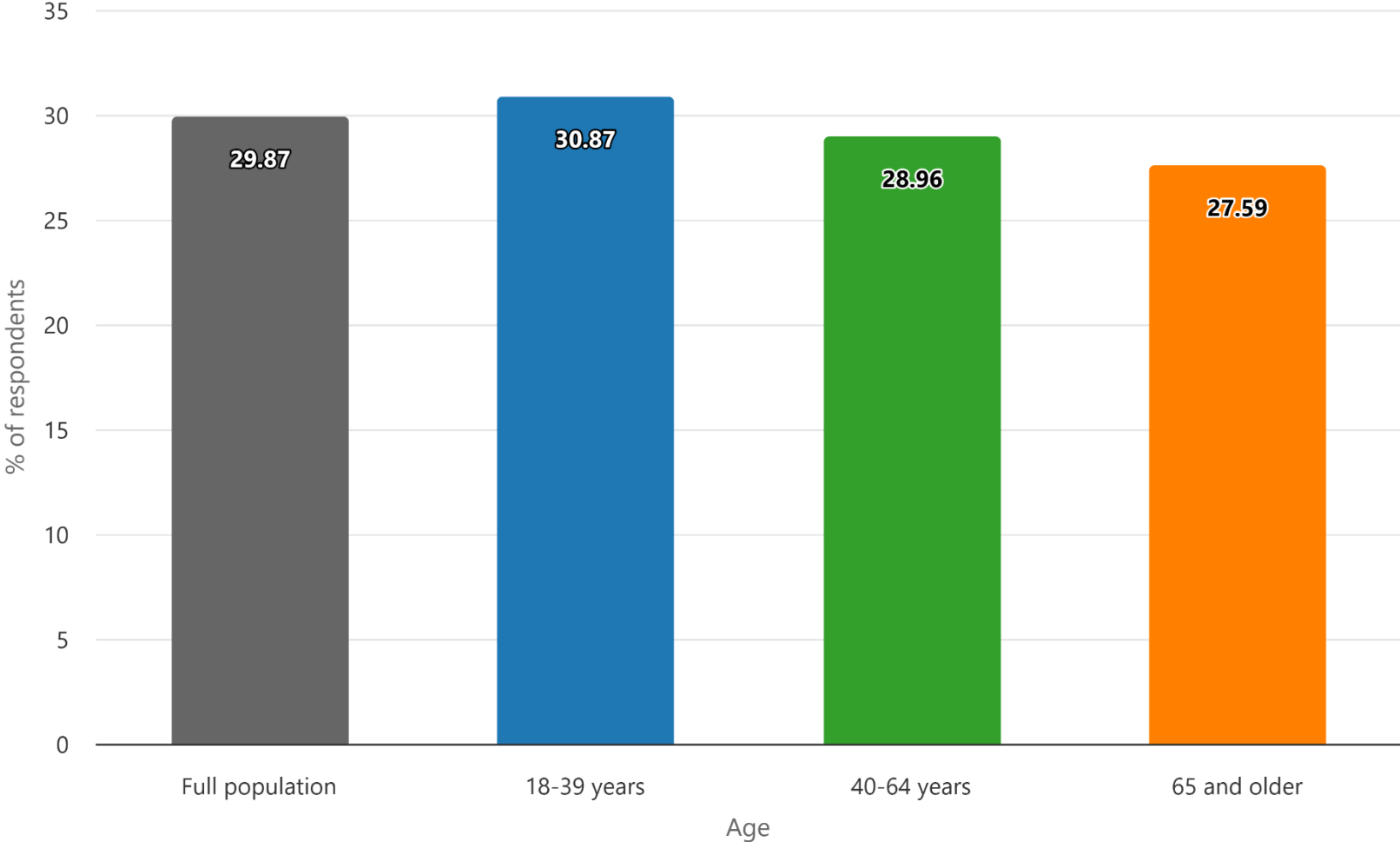

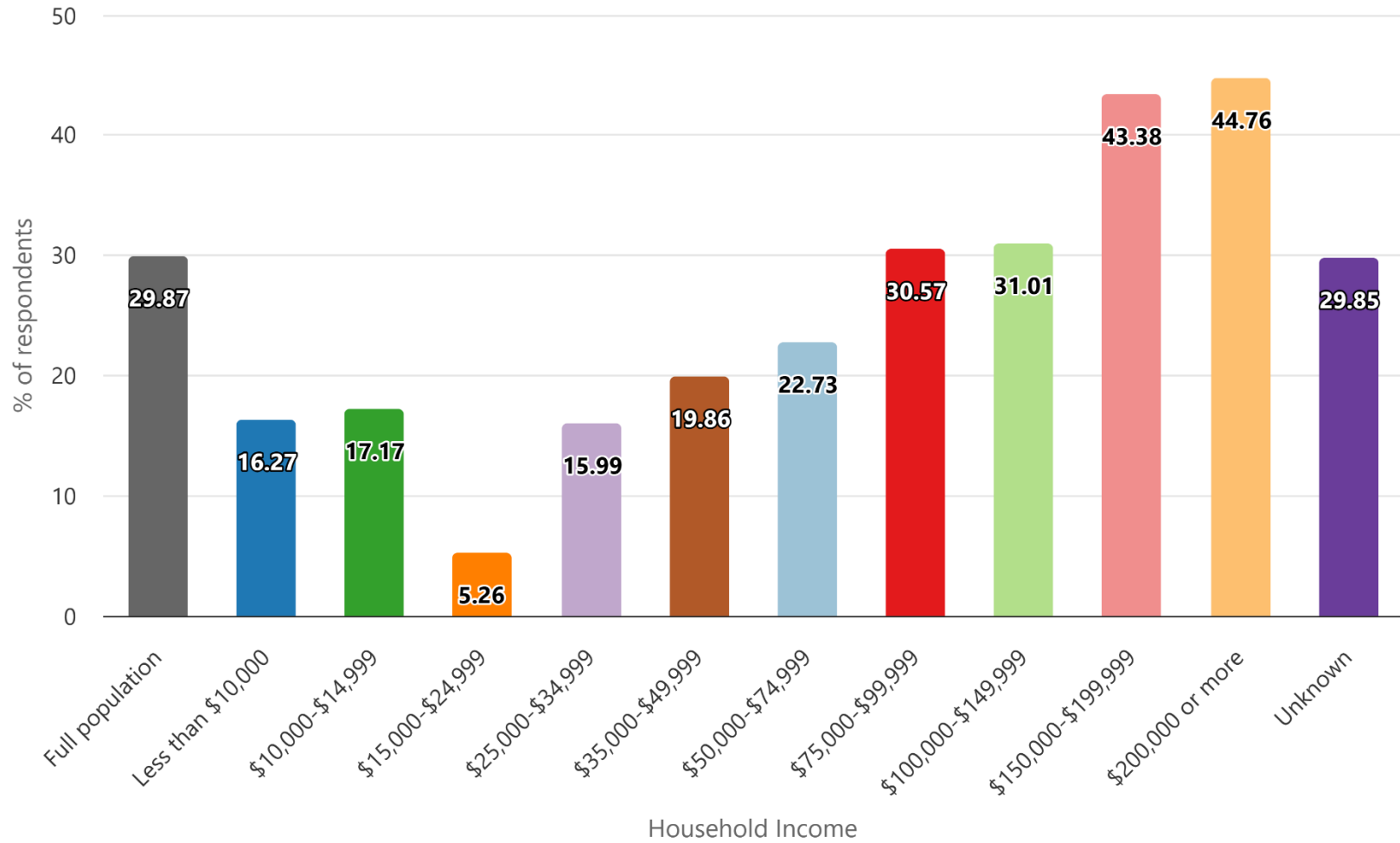

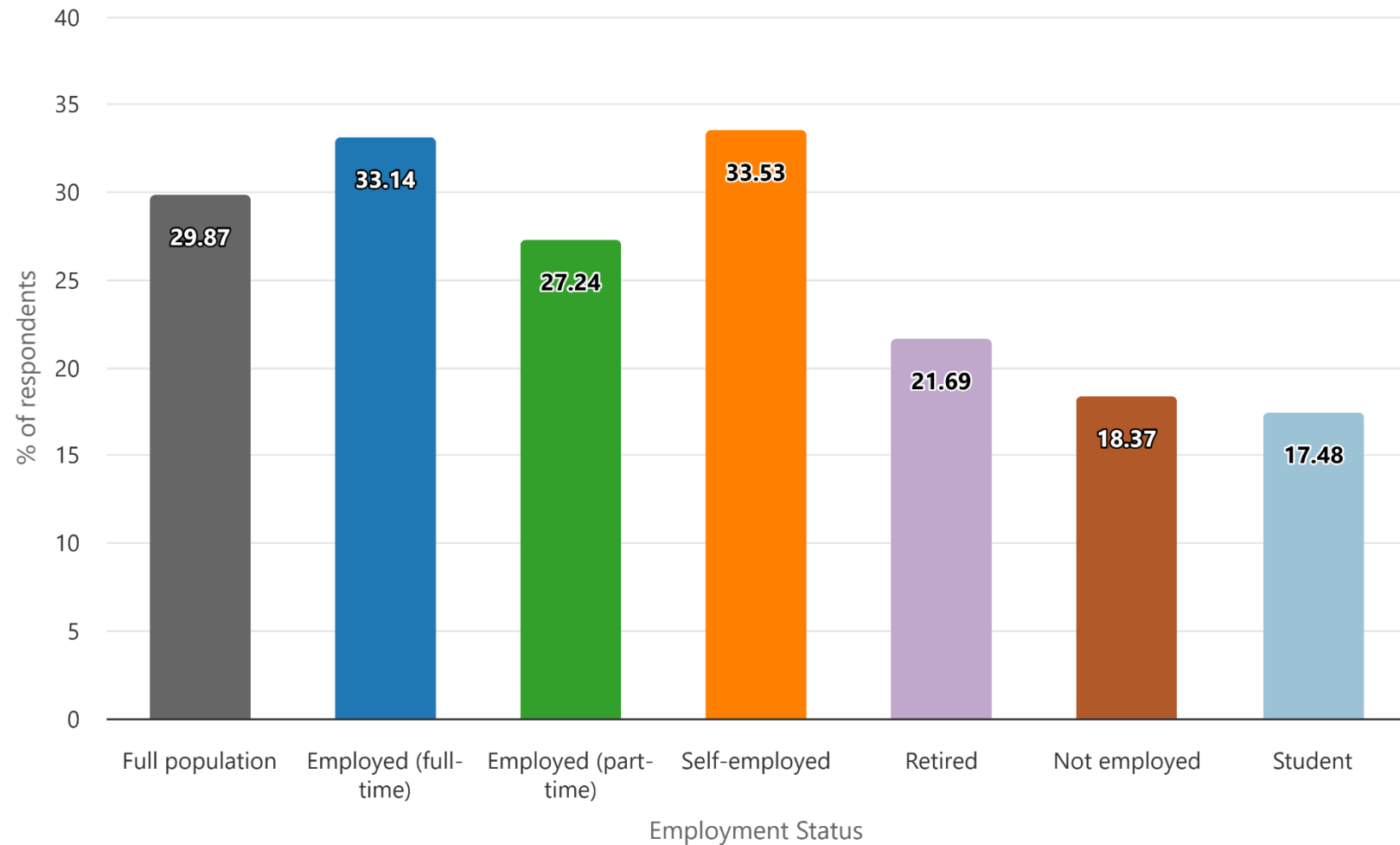

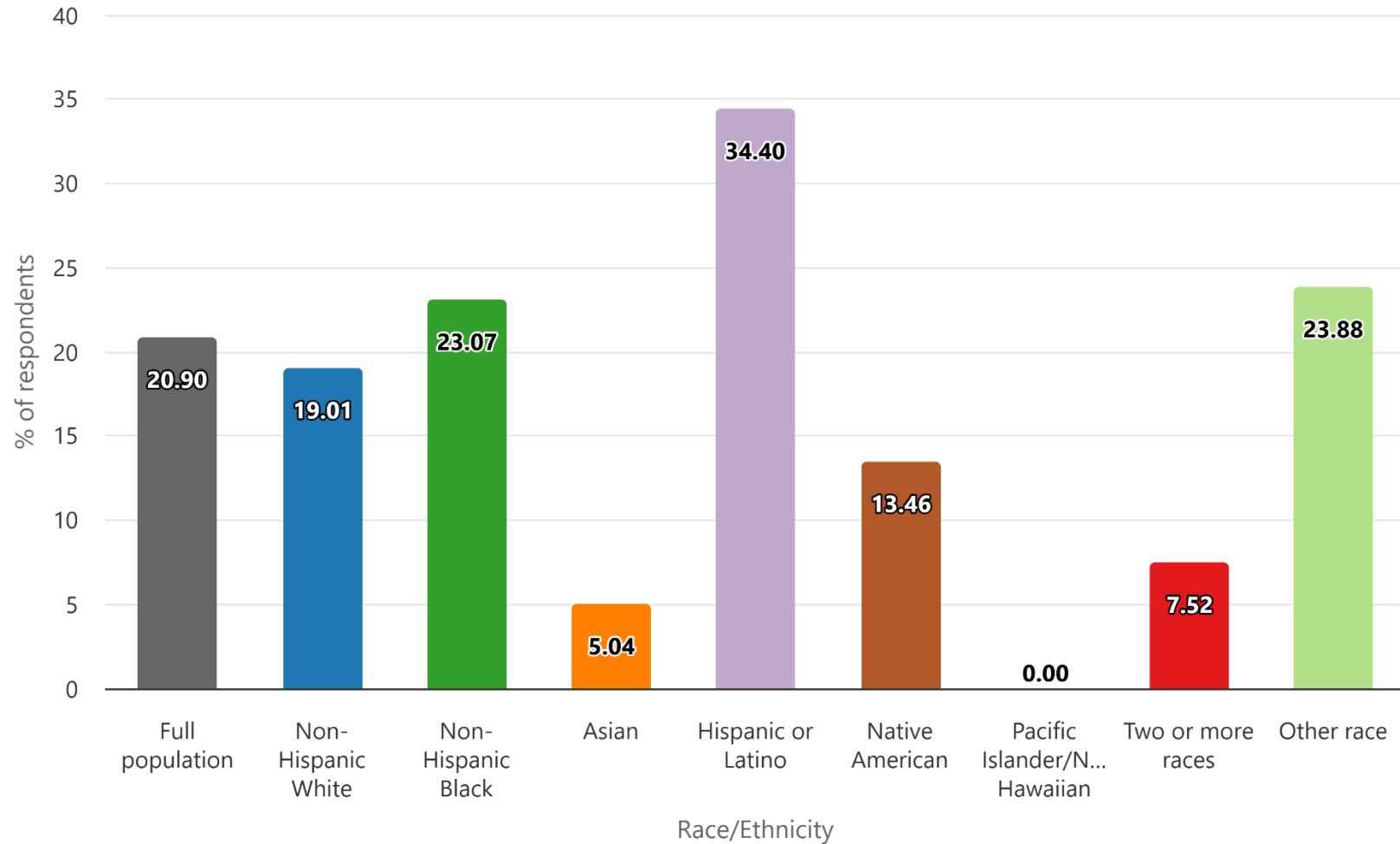

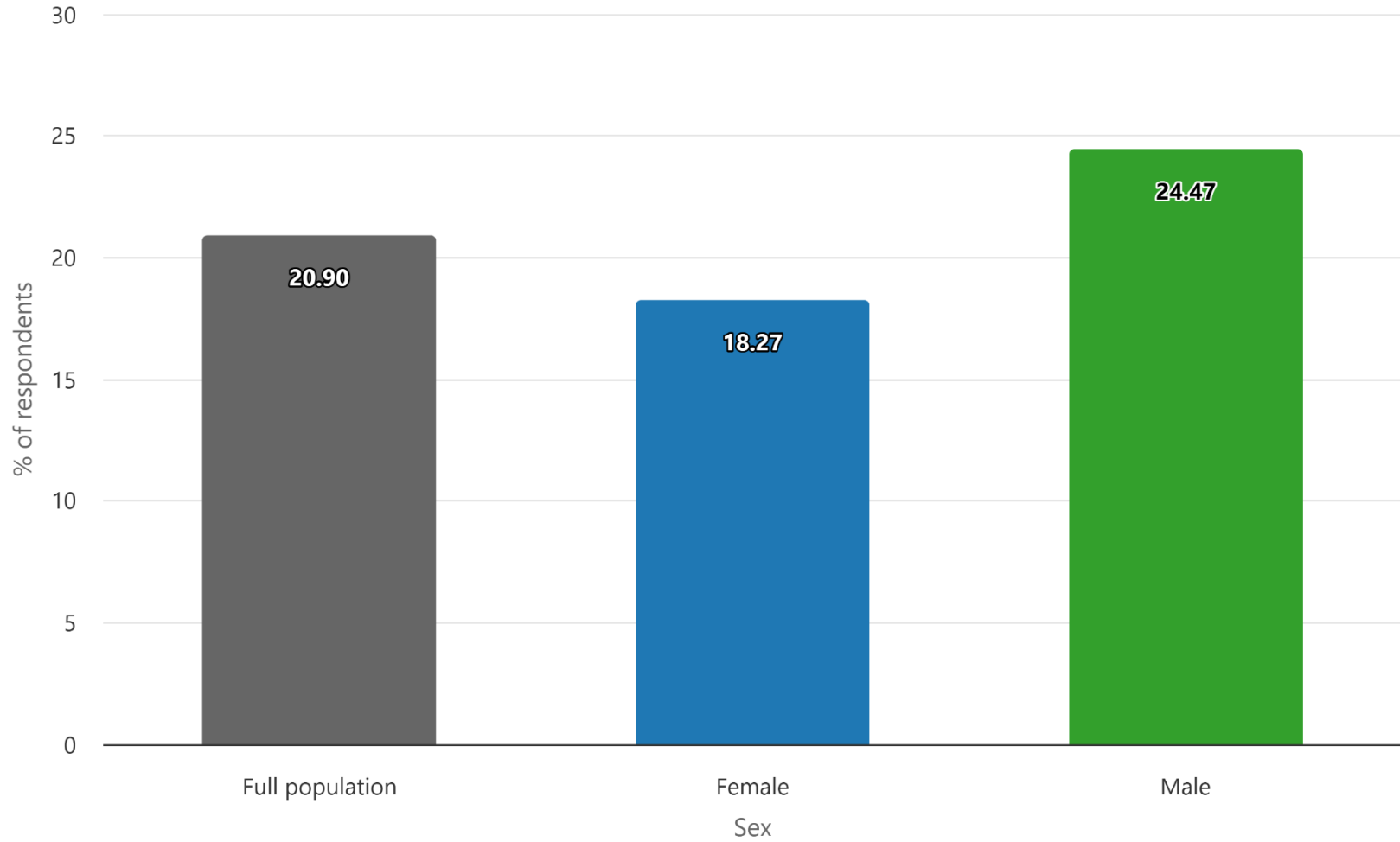

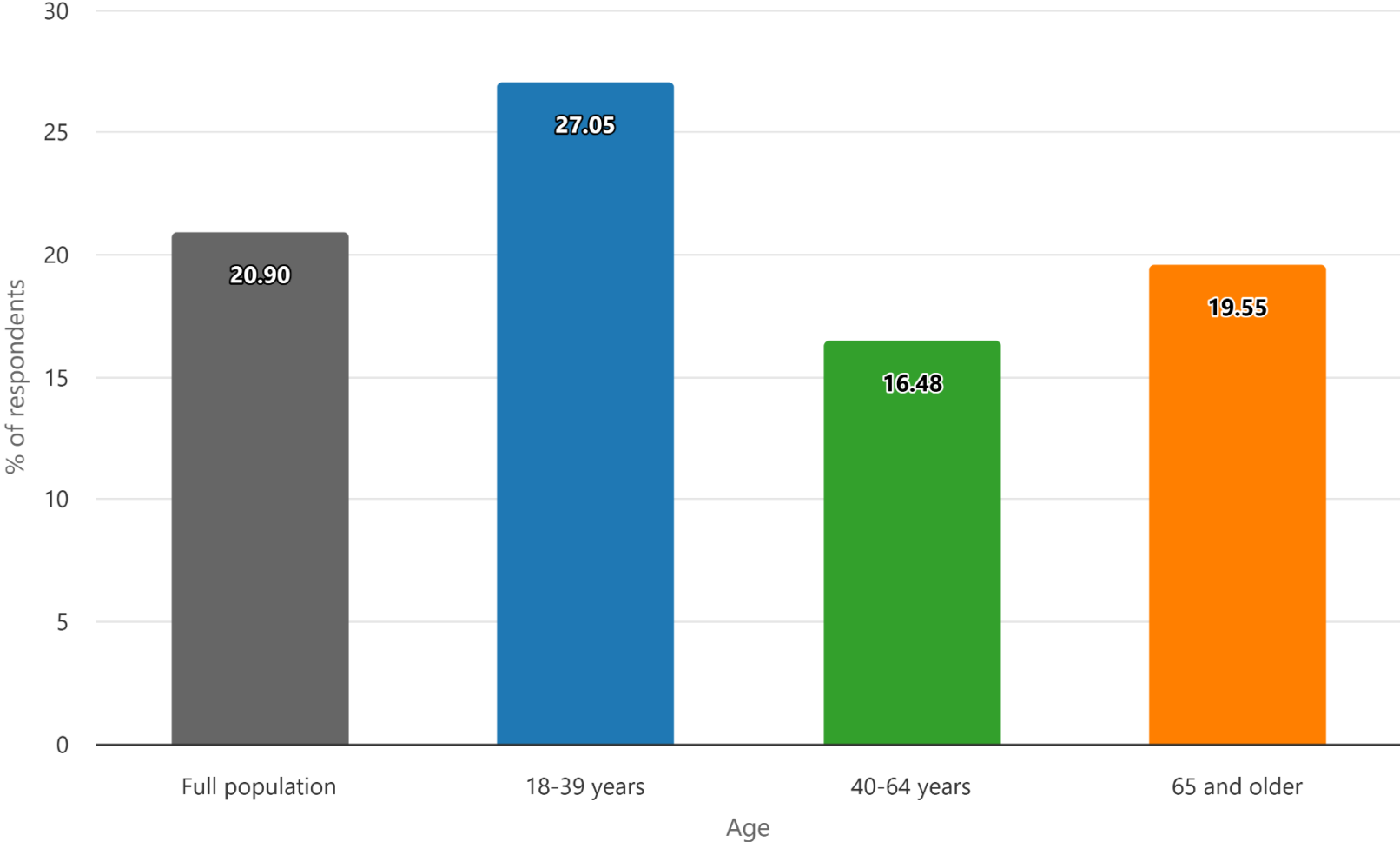

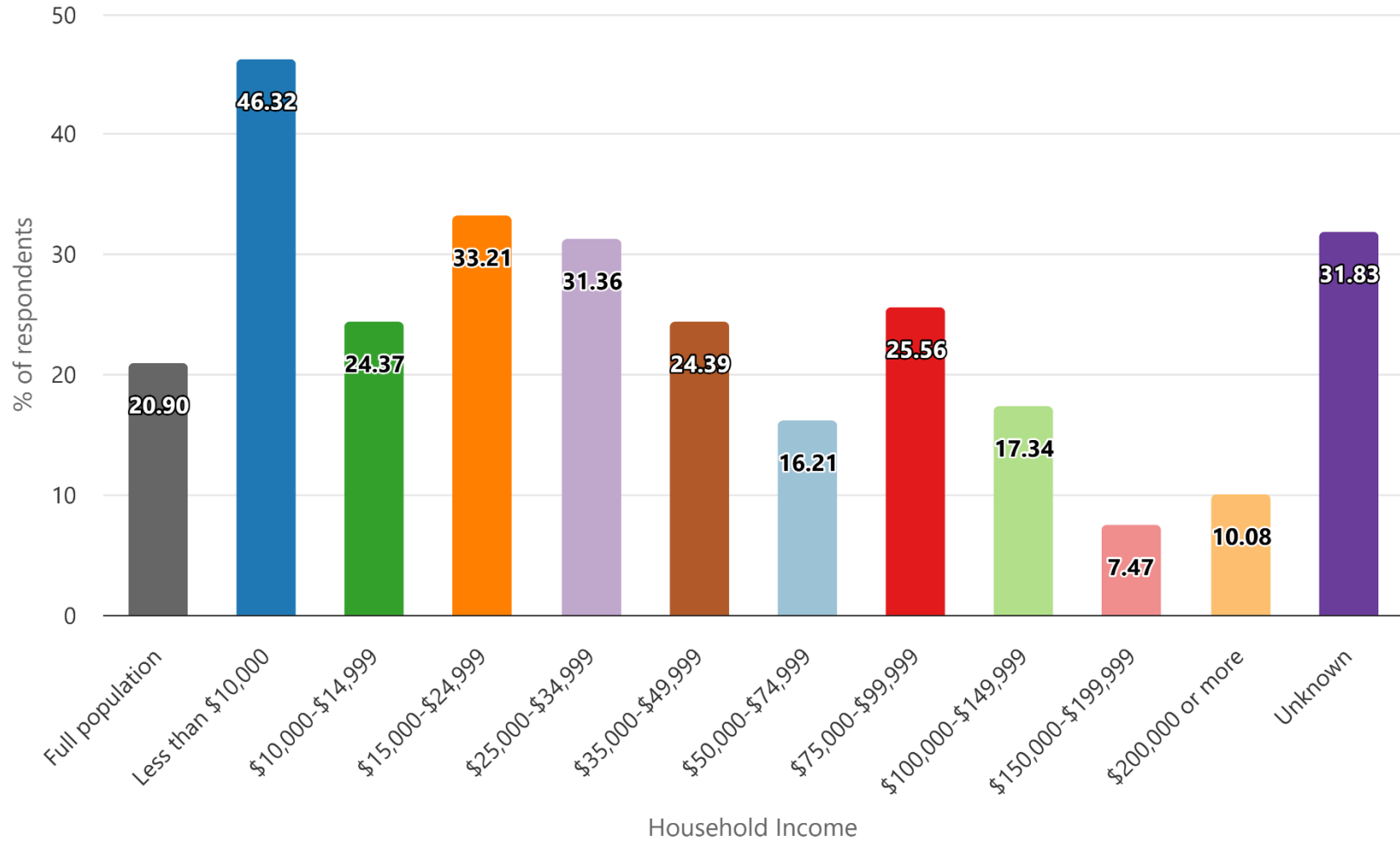

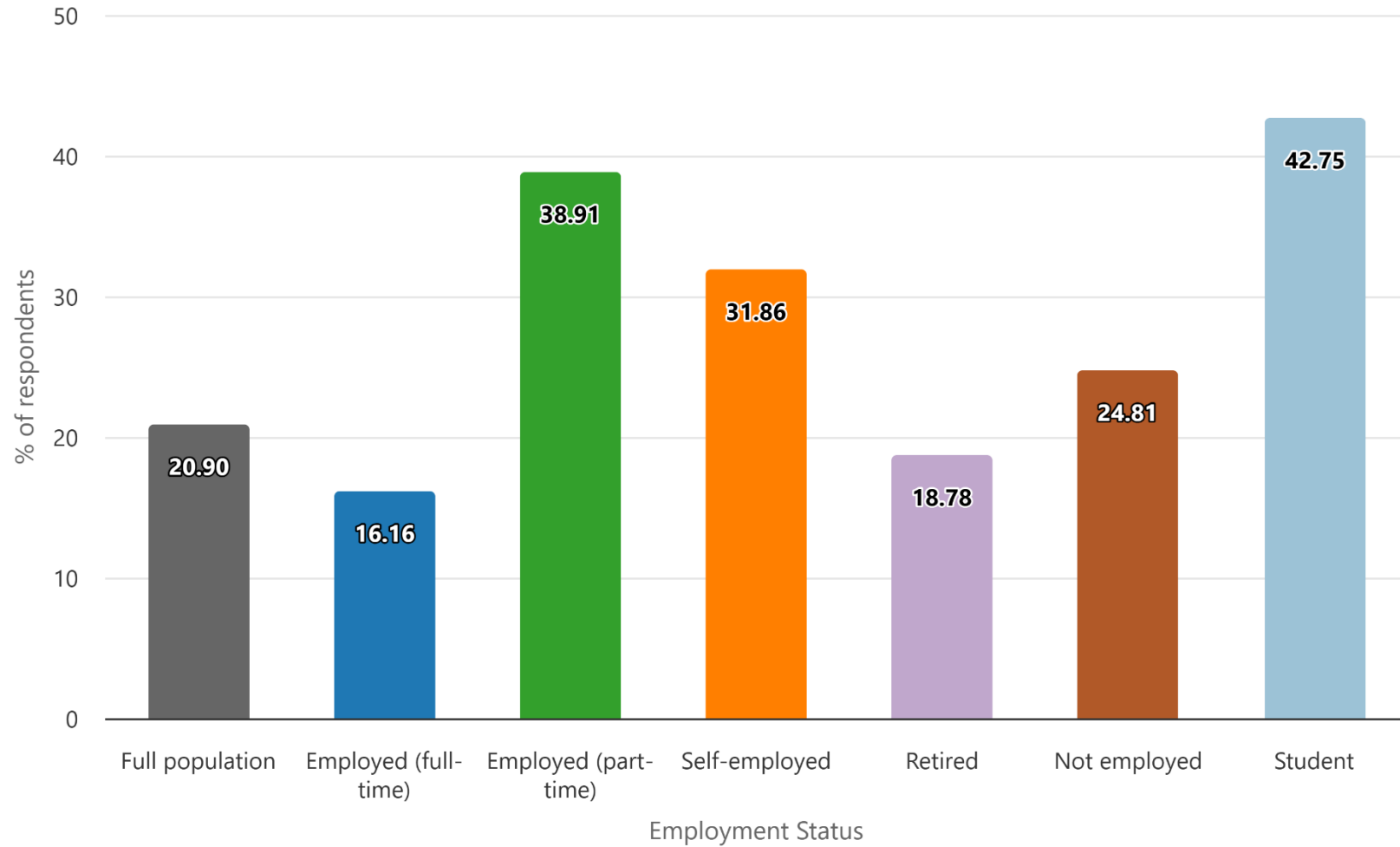

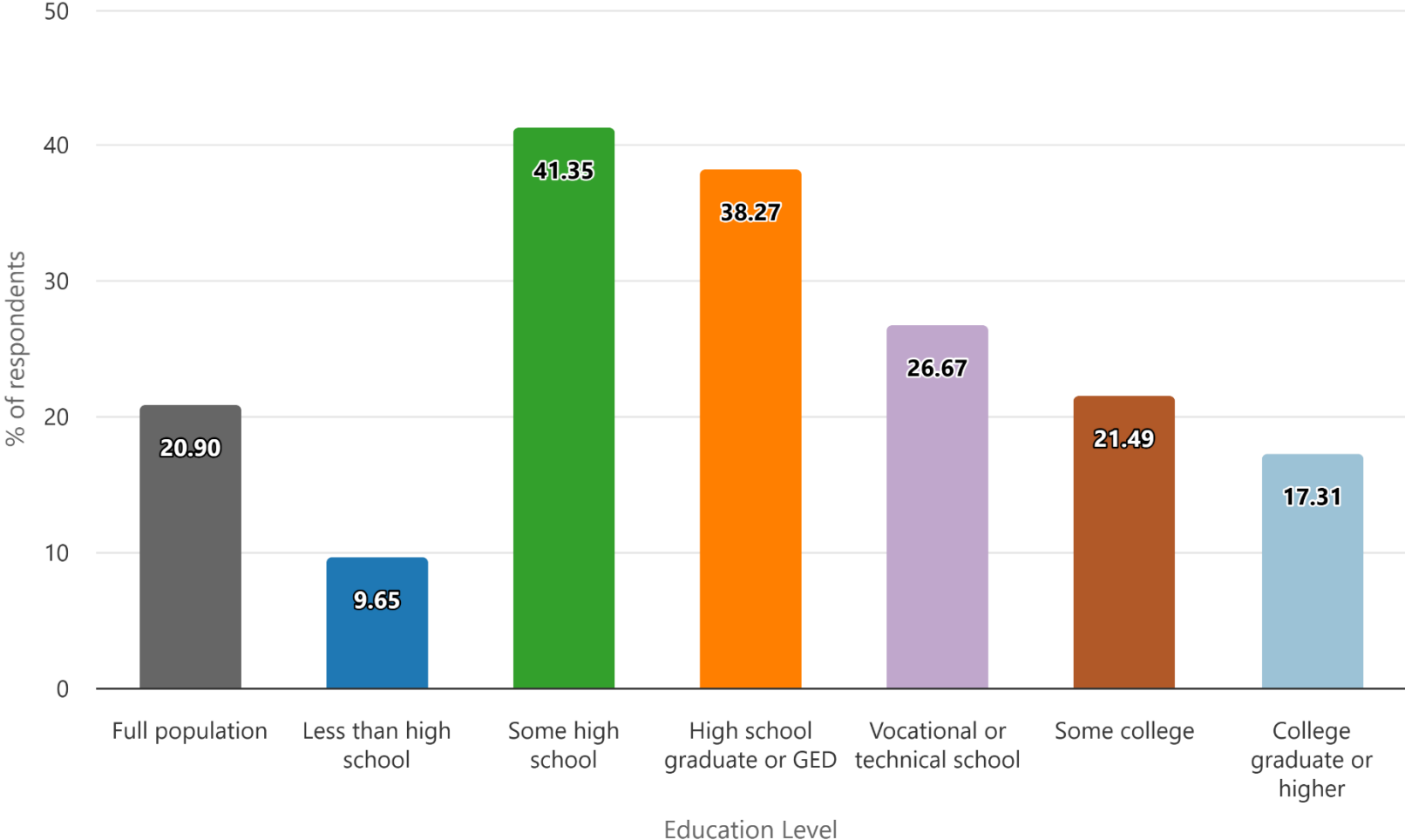

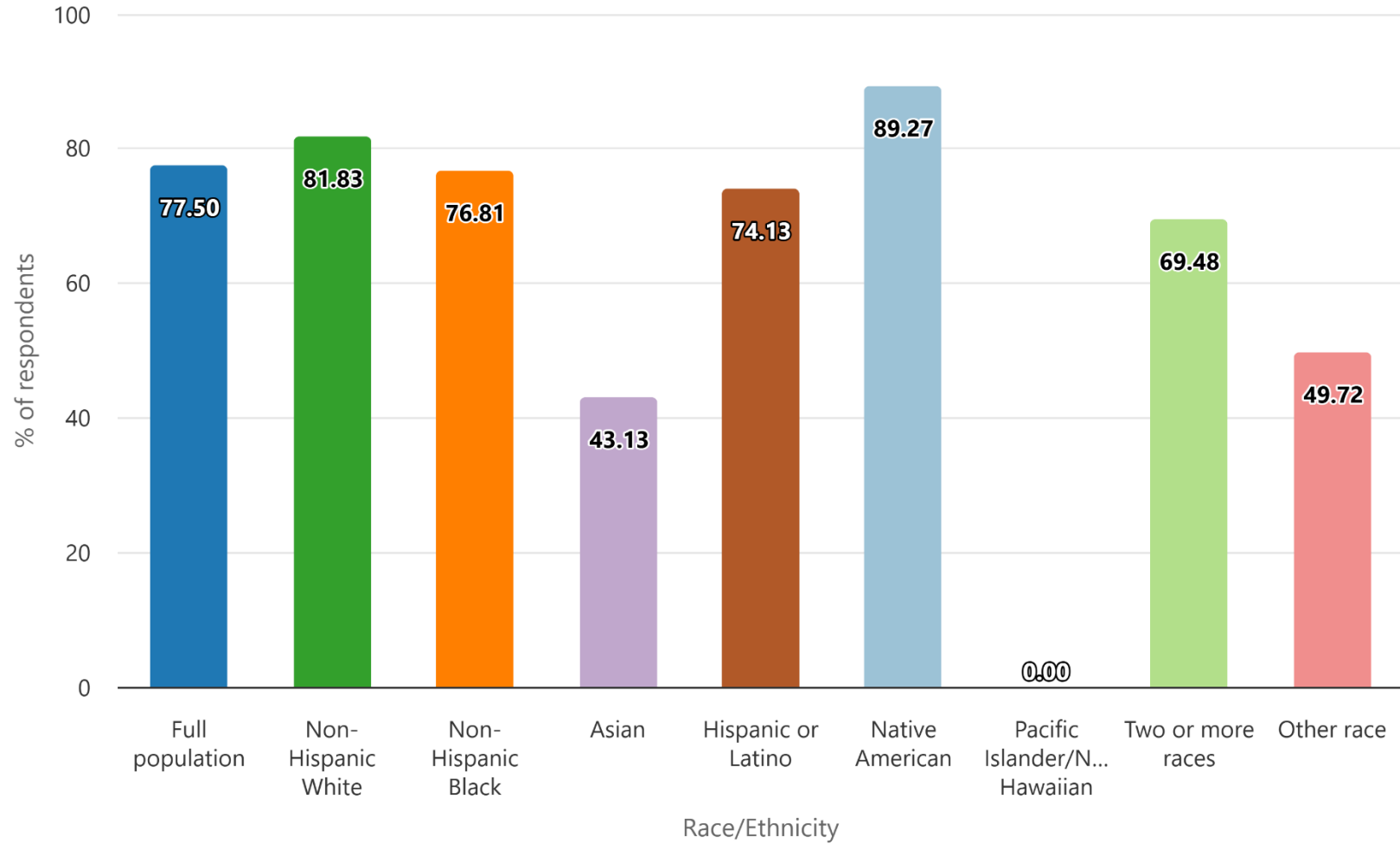

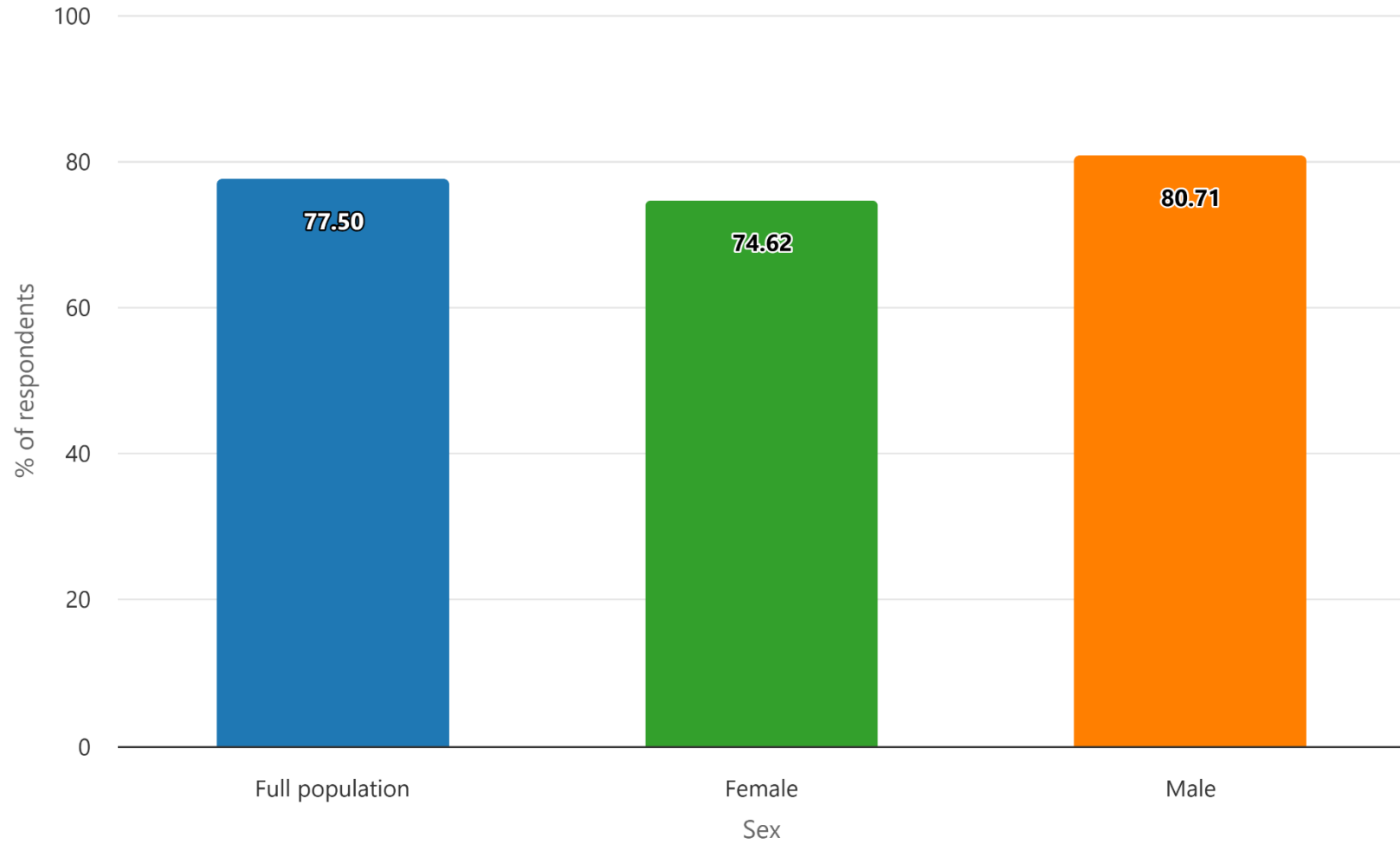

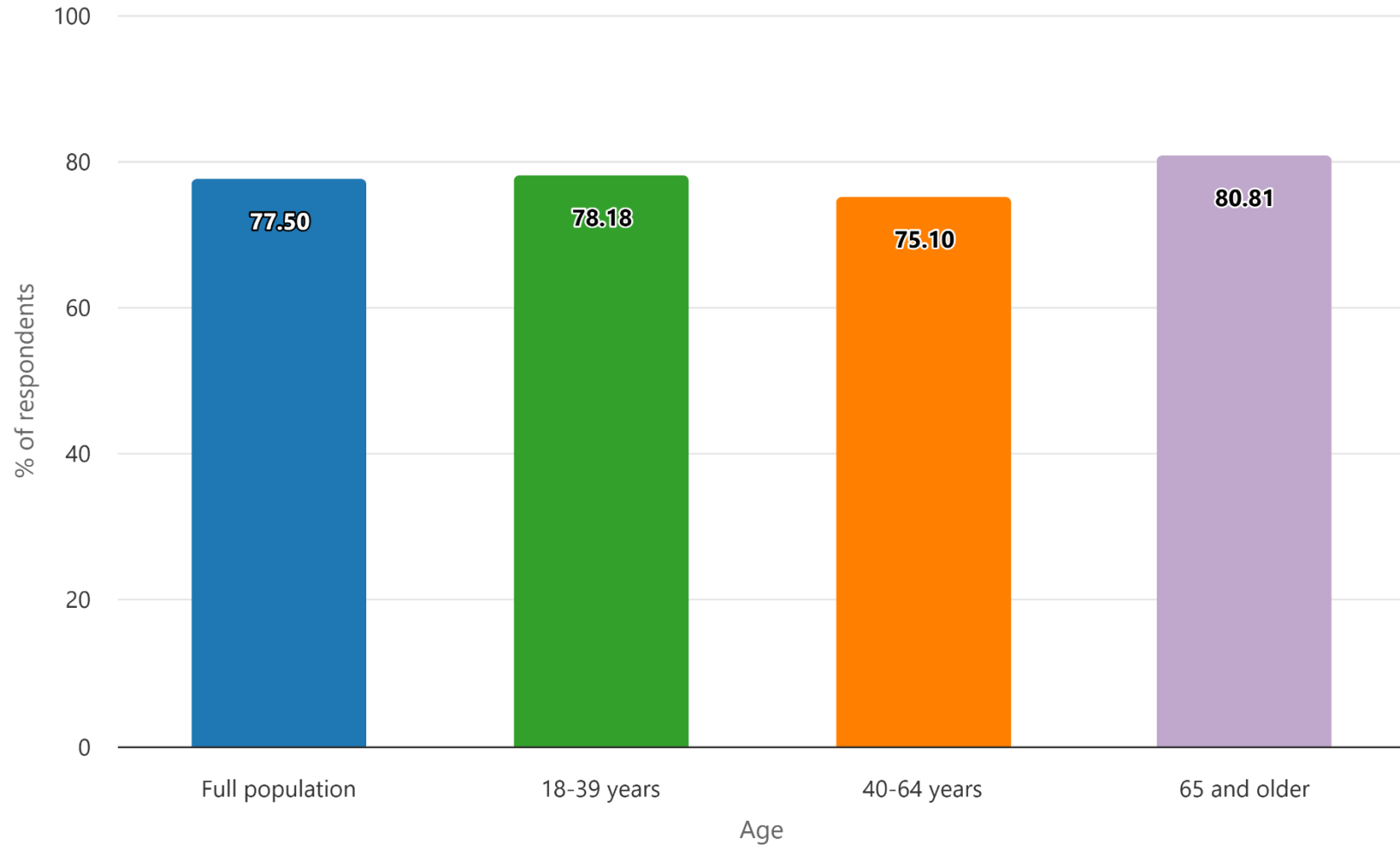

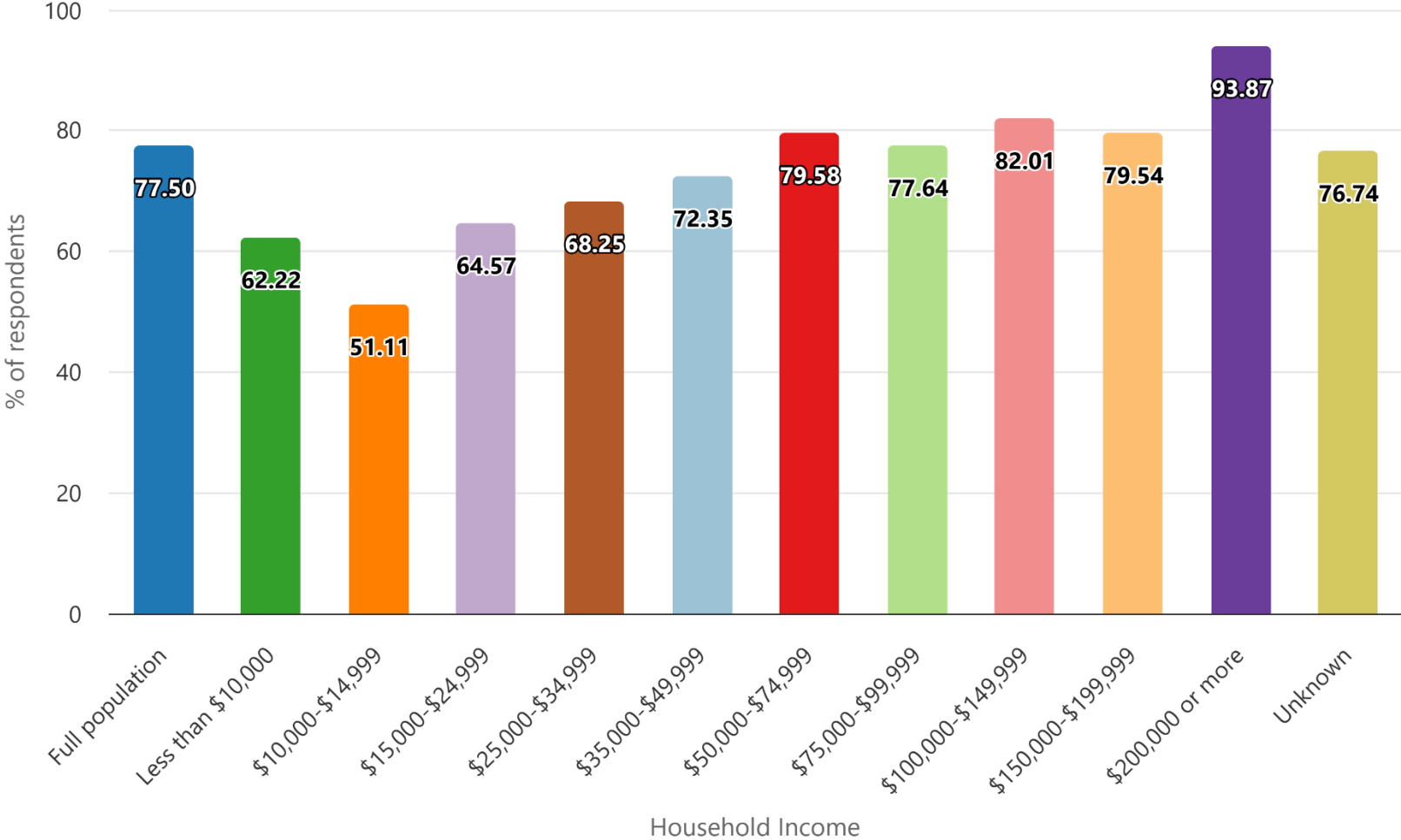

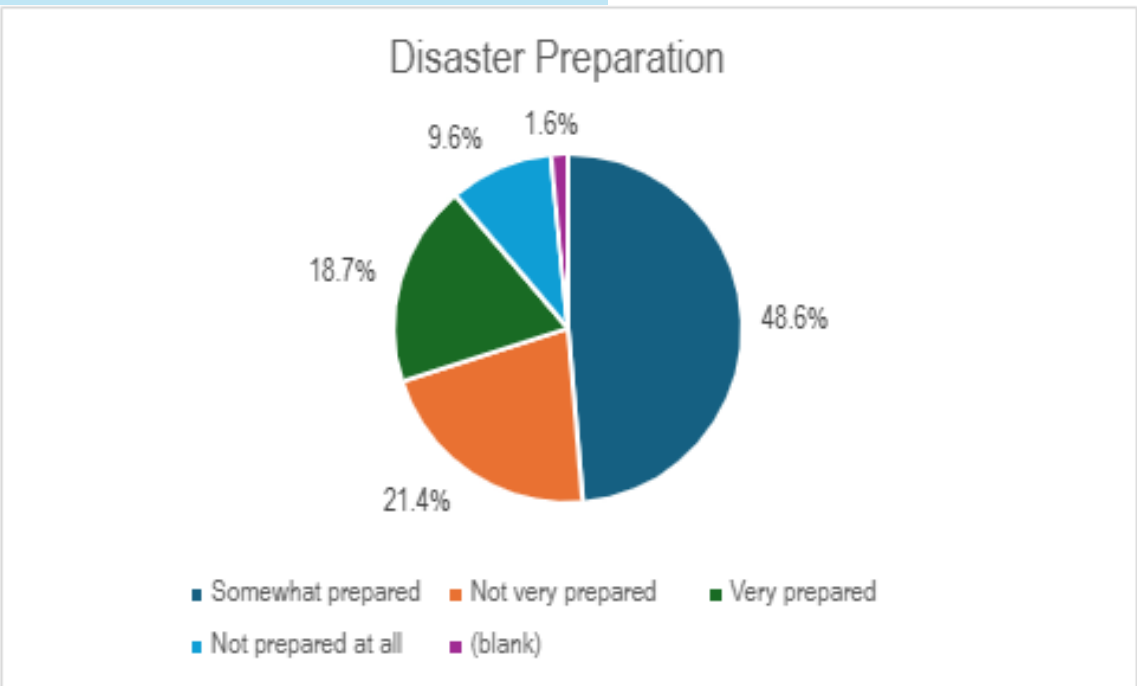

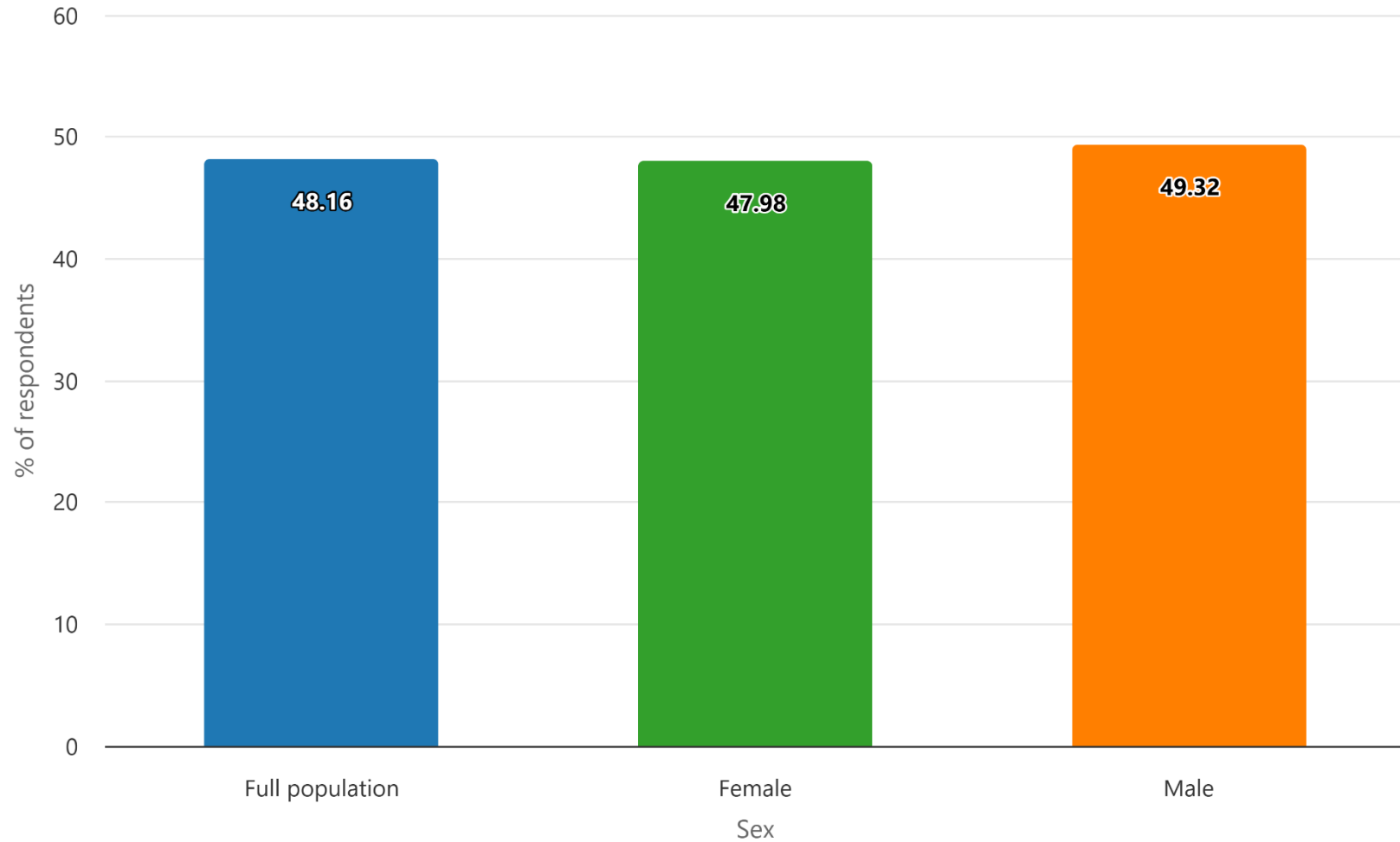

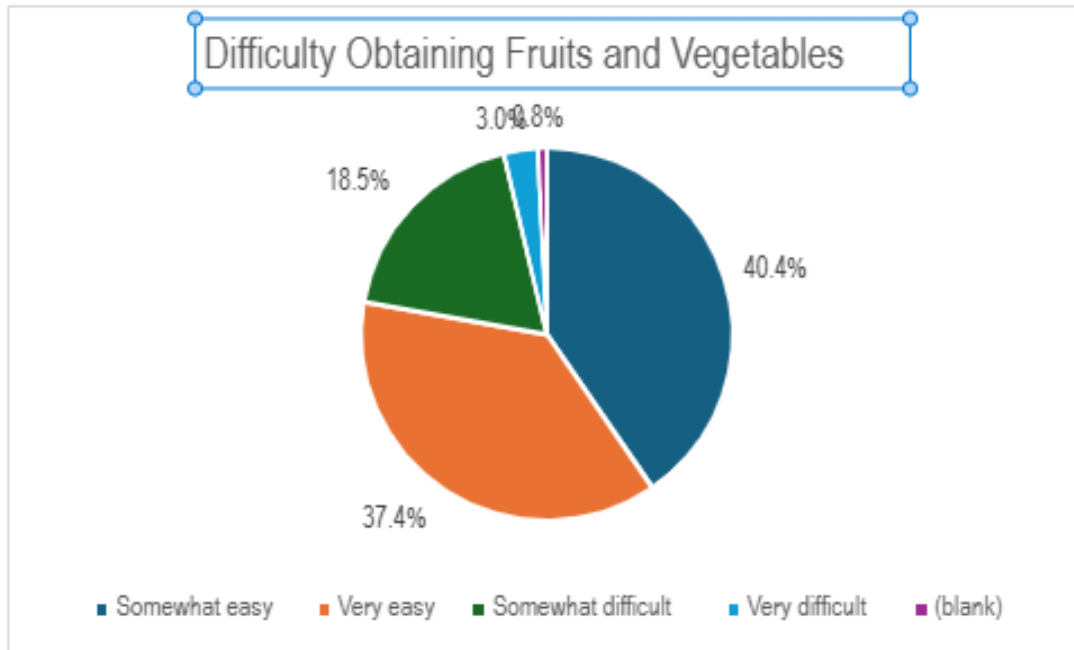

The community health survey responses highlight several key themes for creating a healthier community. **Access to affordable healthcare**, including **mental health services**, is a significant concern, with many participants emphasizing the need for **more healthcare providers** and **reduced wait times for appointments**. **Affordable and healthy food options** are also a priority, with calls **for more farmers' markets and education on nutrition and food preparation**. **Safe and accessible environments for physical activity**, such as **sidewalks, parks, and greenways**, are frequently mentioned, along with **improved public transportation** to facilitate access to these areas. **Affordable housing** and **childcare** are critical needs, as they impact the ability of residents to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Additionally, there is a strong desire for **community engagement and support**, including **social events, educational programs, and resources for vulnerable populations**. Overall, the responses indicate a need for a holistic approach that addresses social determinants of health, **including economic stability, education, and community support systems**.

2025 Cabarrus County Community Needs Assessment

Focus Group Thematic Summary

Overview

Across Spring 2025, Cabarrus County convened a series of focus groups to inform the Community Needs Assessment, including male residents, seniors (LunchPlus Logan and Mt. Pleasant), youth councils, families, and members of the Indian community. These groups were intentionally selected to elevate voices and sectors that were underrepresented in the community survey and to ensure broader inclusion of diverse lived experiences. Participants represented different ages, neighborhoods, and cultural backgrounds across the county.

While residents expressed strong pride in Cabarrus County's growth, schools, and sense of community, they also highlighted mounting pressures—particularly related to affordability, transportation, and access to services—that are increasingly impacting quality of life and long-term stability.

1. Community Strengths

Participants consistently highlighted:

- Strong sense of community connection and collaboration
- Proximity to Charlotte with suburban quality of life
- Good schools and family-friendly environment
- Active downtown spaces and community events
- Programs like LunchPlus that reduce isolation among seniors

Residents value Cabarrus County's growth, diversity, and local engagement, but expressed concern about maintaining community identity amid rapid change.

2. Housing & Growth Pressures

Housing affordability emerged as a top concern across nearly all groups.

Common themes included:

- Rising rents, home prices, and property taxes
- Limited affordable and starter homes
- Seniors and working families being priced out
- Gentrification in historically established communities
- Overcrowding in schools tied to housing growth

Housing was one of the most frequently identified priorities (notably among male residents and CCM Family Night participants).

3. Transportation & Infrastructure

Transportation was a major barrier affecting access to employment, healthcare, education, and social engagement.

Key concerns:

- Overreliance on personal vehicles
- Limited or confusing bus routes
- Long waitlists for senior transportation services
- Lack of shelters/seating at bus stops
- Inability to travel outside county lines for services
- Traffic congestion and inadequate road infrastructure

Transportation was consistently ranked as a top community priority, particularly among families and seniors.

4. Mental Health & Behavioral Health

Mental health needs were widely identified across demographic groups:

- Stigma remains strong, particularly among men and within certain cultural communities
- Limited male-focused spaces for mental health conversations
- Teen mental health concerns
- Substance use and vaping among youth
- Need for safe spaces for women experiencing isolation or domestic violence
- Long wait times and affordability barriers

Mental health was one of the most frequently cited top priorities across groups.

5. Access to Healthcare

While some residents reported that care is available, significant barriers were noted:

- Long wait times (4+ months for preventive visits)
- High copays and specialist costs
- Strain on emergency departments
- Limited dental coverage

- Transportation-related appointment disruptions
- Lack of awareness about available services

Participants also expressed concern that the healthcare system feels profit-driven rather than patient-centered.

6. Senior Support & Aging Services

Older adults expressed strong appreciation for programs like LunchPlus but voiced concern about:

- Cuts to senior programming and outings
- Isolation and lack of activities
- Limited in-home assistance programs
- Technology barriers
- Insufficient communication about available resources
- “Benefits gap” — earning too much to qualify for assistance, but not enough to meet basic needs

Social connection was described as essential to health and well-being.

7. Youth & Education

Youth participants identified:

- School overcrowding and staff shortages
- Transportation barriers limiting after-school participation
- Limited accessible recreational spaces
- Stress from academic and policy changes
- Need for stronger health education and mental health resources
- Concerns about vaping, violence, and school safety

Youth emphasized the importance of belonging, extracurricular opportunities, and teacher stability.

8. Safety & Community Trust

Safety concerns varied by group but included:

- Crime and lack of neighborhood patrols
- School safety concerns

- Targeted break-ins in specific communities
- Limited culturally responsive law enforcement engagement
- Water quality concerns (Kannapolis)

Participants expressed a desire for increased transparency, communication, and visible community investment.

9. Communication & Resource Awareness

Across nearly all groups, residents emphasized:

- Difficulty finding information about services and programs
- Lack of centralized communication
- Need for better outreach to diverse communities
- Reliance on word-of-mouth

Communication and resource awareness ranked among the highest priorities in the Indian community focus group.

Cross-Cutting Top Priorities

The most consistently identified community priorities across focus groups were:

1. Affordable Housing
2. Transportation & Infrastructure
3. Mental Health & Substance Use
4. Access to Care
5. Communication & Resource Awareness
6. Senior Support & Social Connection

Background Information: The Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) is a process designed to assess the health status, needs, and available resources within a county. Now conducted every three years, the CHNA culminates in a comprehensive report that is shared with the community. It is important to note that the purpose of this process is not to develop solutions, but rather to identify community needs, highlight gaps in services, foster analysis and discussion, and encourage stakeholders—including agencies, businesses, individuals, and organizations—to engage in strategic and programmatic planning to address these needs.

A Community Planning Council has been convened in association with each CHNA since 2000, including in 2004, 2008, 2012, 2016, and 2020. The Council is composed of a diverse group of representatives from health and human services, the faith community, education, city and county government, foundations, businesses, and community volunteers. The primary role of the Planning Council is to gather, analyze, and interpret county-level data, contribute to the development of the CHNA report, and ensure that the results are effectively disseminated to the broader community.

Qualifications for Council Members:

- Strong ability to listen, analyze, think critically and creatively, and collaborate effectively with individuals and groups.
- Willingness to actively prepare for and attend Community Planning Council meetings, ask thoughtful questions, take responsibility for assigned tasks, and follow through on commitments.
- Demonstrates honesty, integrity, and sensitivity to diverse perspectives, with the ability to share relevant and timely information.
- Strong commitment to the shared mission of Healthy Cabarrus: *To unite and commit time, talents, and financial resources to create a healthy community and a hopeful future for all citizens.*

Council Member Responsibilities:

- Review the agenda and any supplemental materials prior to meetings.
- Provide relevant data; assist with community survey collection and contribute insights based on your area of expertise.
- Actively participate in discussions by asking questions and offering input.
- Help prioritize community needs and identify gaps.
- Serve on subcommittees as needed.
- Share CHNA findings and processes within the community.
